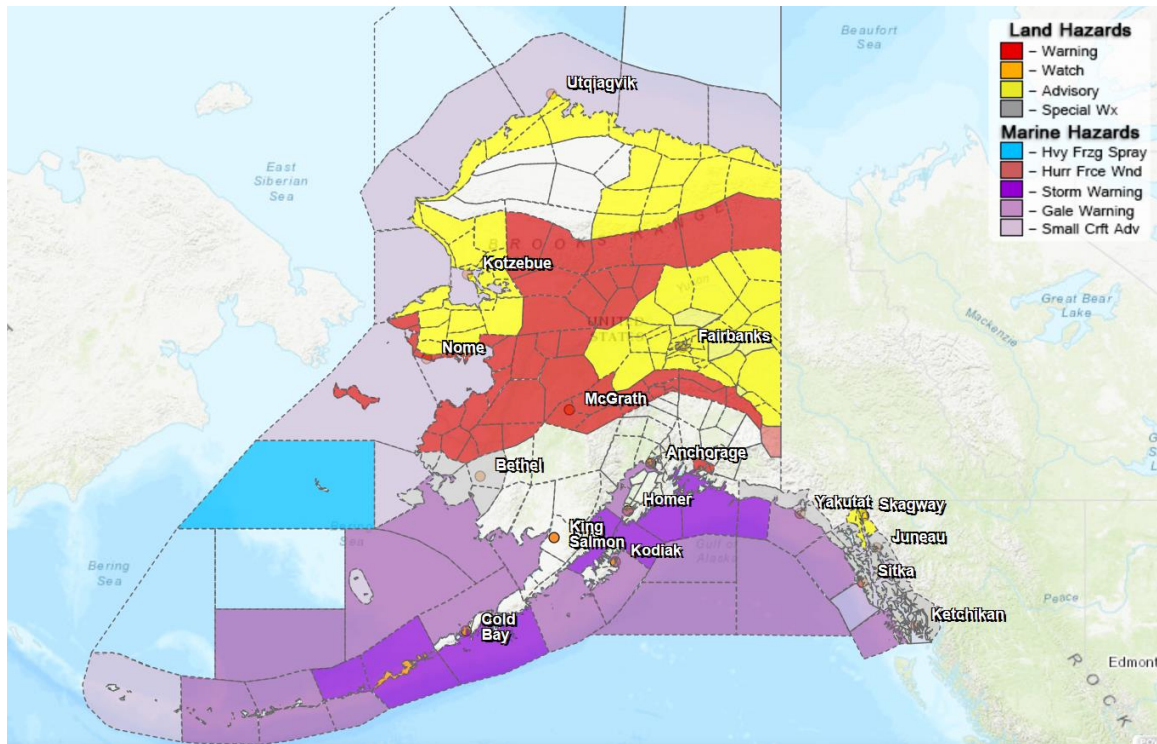
**Gambell Water System Freeze UP**

The SEOC contacted Gambell last Friday. He says their water plant is producing water for about an hour per day which is insufficient to serve the community’s domestic water needs. A new water pump arrived Friday and they were to install this weekend. The SEOC will follow up with Gambell’s leadership today.
