The SEOC continues to be activated to Level 3 in response to the M7.0 earthquake affecting the Municipality of Anchorage, Matanuska-Susitna Borough, and Kenai Peninsula Borough. AEA confirms the repairman from Nome has reached the island is working on getting all generators running. He plans to work on the distribution system tomorrow.

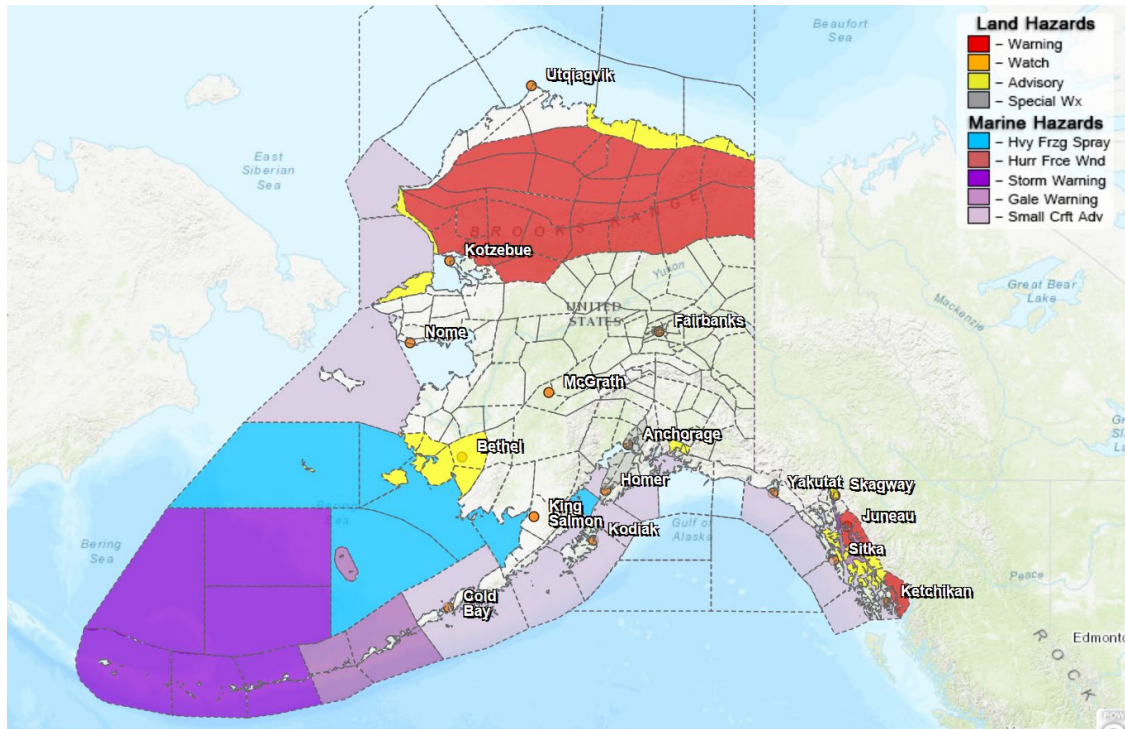
**Thorne Bay Landslide**

The SEOC is reviewing land deed and ownership documents for the damaged road near Thorne Bay. There remains some question as to the ownership and legal responsibility for repairing the road. As soon as these ownership questions are resolved, the SEOC will determine if the road is eligible for Federal Highway Administration emergency repair funding.
