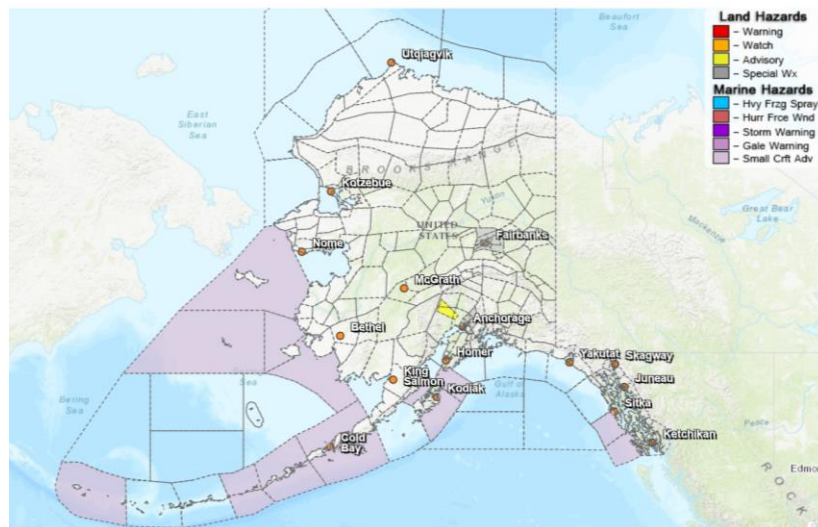
**Cook Inlet M7.1 Earthquake (FEMA Declaration DR-4413)**

DHS&EM, FEMA, and other federal agencies are managing the recovery efforts associated with the Cook Inlet M7.1 earthquake at the Joint Field Office (JFO) in Anchorage.

**Swan Lake Wildfire**

Currently, the Swan Lake Wildfire is being managed locally by a Unified Command and the Kenai Peninsula Borough has not requested any support from the State. DHS&EM has reached out to the Alaska Partnership for Infrastructure Protection (APIP) to assess the impacts and potential needs of commercial, non-profit, and utility providers due to the fire's likely progress. The SEOC will continue to monitor the wildfire situation state-wide. One impact is that smoke from the wildfire continues to degrade the air quality in Southcentral AK. The Alaska Interagency Coordination Center reports the Swan Lake Fire has burnt 40,383.0 acres so far.
