THREAT LEVEL CHANGES: SEOC LEVEL 1 – ROUTINE OPERATIONS

NTAS BULLETIN: On January 4, 2020, Acting Secretary of Homeland Security Chad F. Wolf issued a new National Terrorism Advisory System (NTAS) Bulletin pertaining to the changing threat landscape following the successful U.S.-led airstrike in Iraq that eliminated Qassem Soleimani, the head of the Iranian Revolutionary Guard Corps-Quds Force, a U.S.-designated Foreign Terrorist Organization.

Significant Issues: The SEOC has been notified of the Big Eddy Road ice jam. The SEOC is in contact with the Kenai Peninsula Bureau and continues to monitor the situation.

The SEOC continues to monitor the response and recovery efforts underway for the flooding along Willow Creek in the Matanuska Susitna Borough (MSB).

An air quality stage two alert has been issued for the Fairbanks and North Pole areas. A stage 2 alert means unhealthy air conditions for sensitive groups.

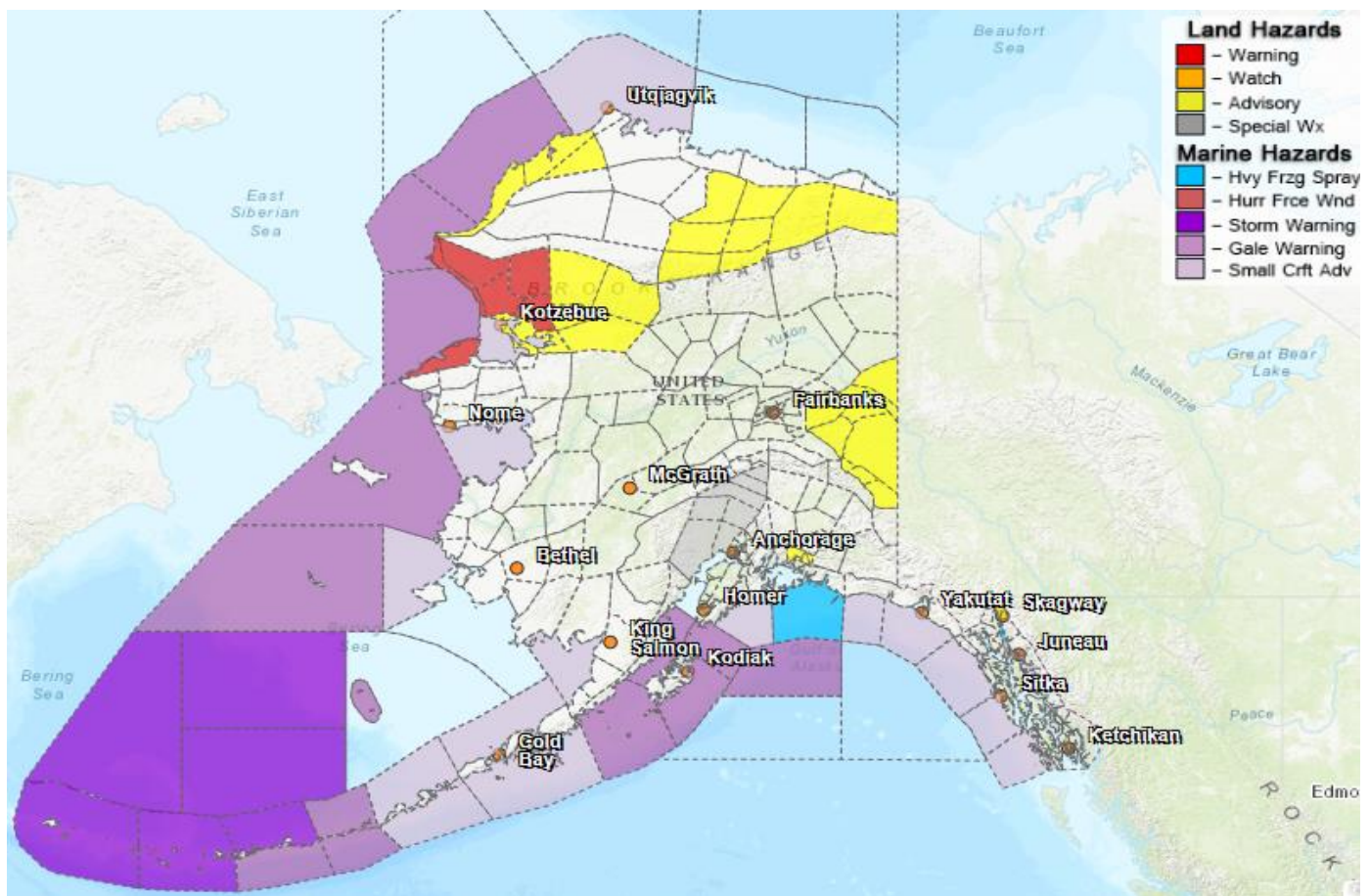

Significant Weather:



A wind chill advisory is in effect for the Taiya Inlet and Klondike Highway, Northeast Prince William Sound, White Pass, and the Upper Tanana Valley and Fortymile Country.

A winter weather advisory is in effect for the Northeastern Brooks Range, Western Arctic Coast, Baldwin Peninsula and Selwaik Valley, and the Upper Kobuk and Noatak Valleys.

A blizzard warning is in effect for the Chukchi Sea Coast, and the Lower Kobuk and Noatak Valleys.

A flood advisory has been issued for the Western Kenai Peninsula.

A hydrologic outlook has been provided for the Susitna Valley.
