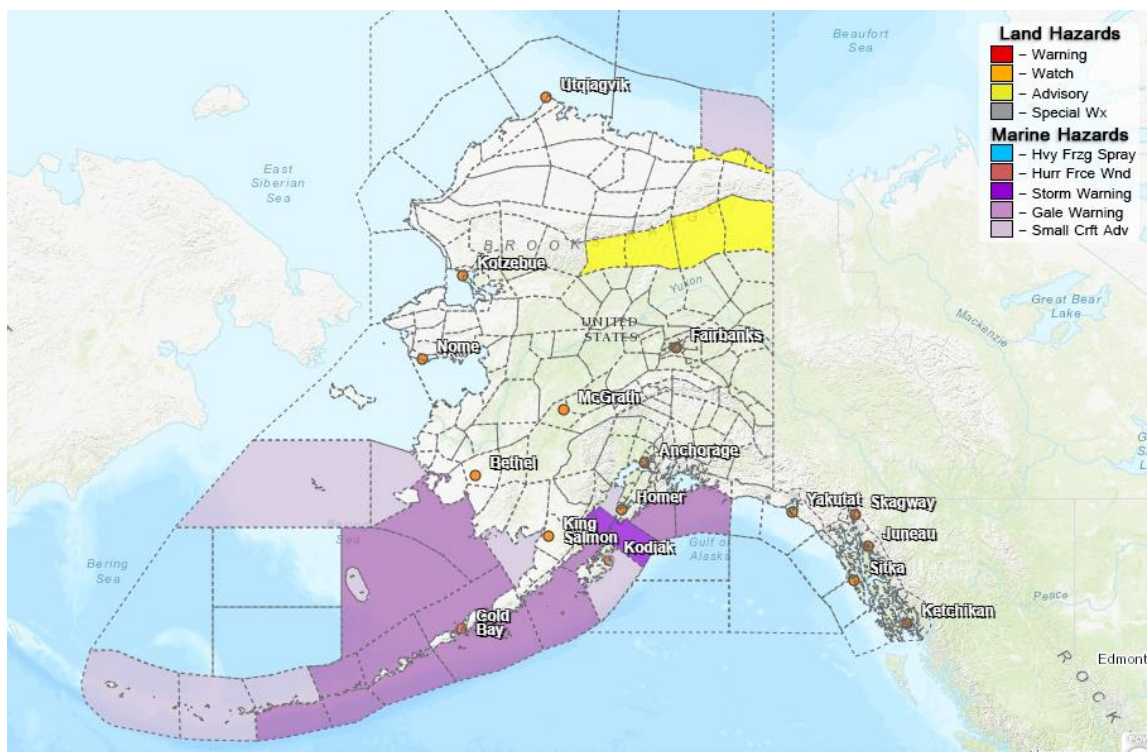

Significant Weather:



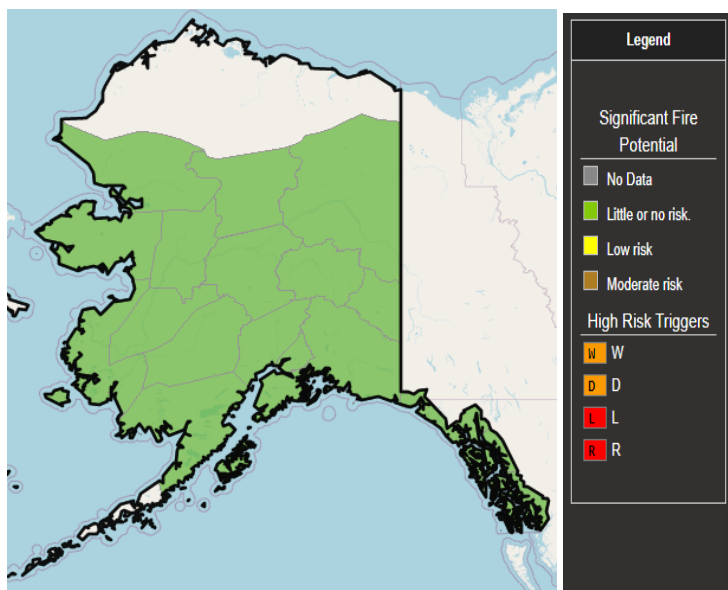
Winter Weather Advisories have been issued for the following areas:
