Significant Issues:

Munson Creek Fire - Chena Hot Springs Road, Fairbanks:

Cooler temperatures and some light precipitation moderated fire behavior yesterday afternoon. Yesterday the SEOC coordinated with the Fairbanks North Star Borough, Mass Care, and volunteer agencies supporting evacuees and those residents sheltering in place. Red Cross is prepared to establish an evacuation shelter if required. Alaska State Forestry continues active fire suppression with almost 150 firefighters and multiple aircraft dedicated to the incident. Updates and additional information at <https://akfireinfo.com/>
