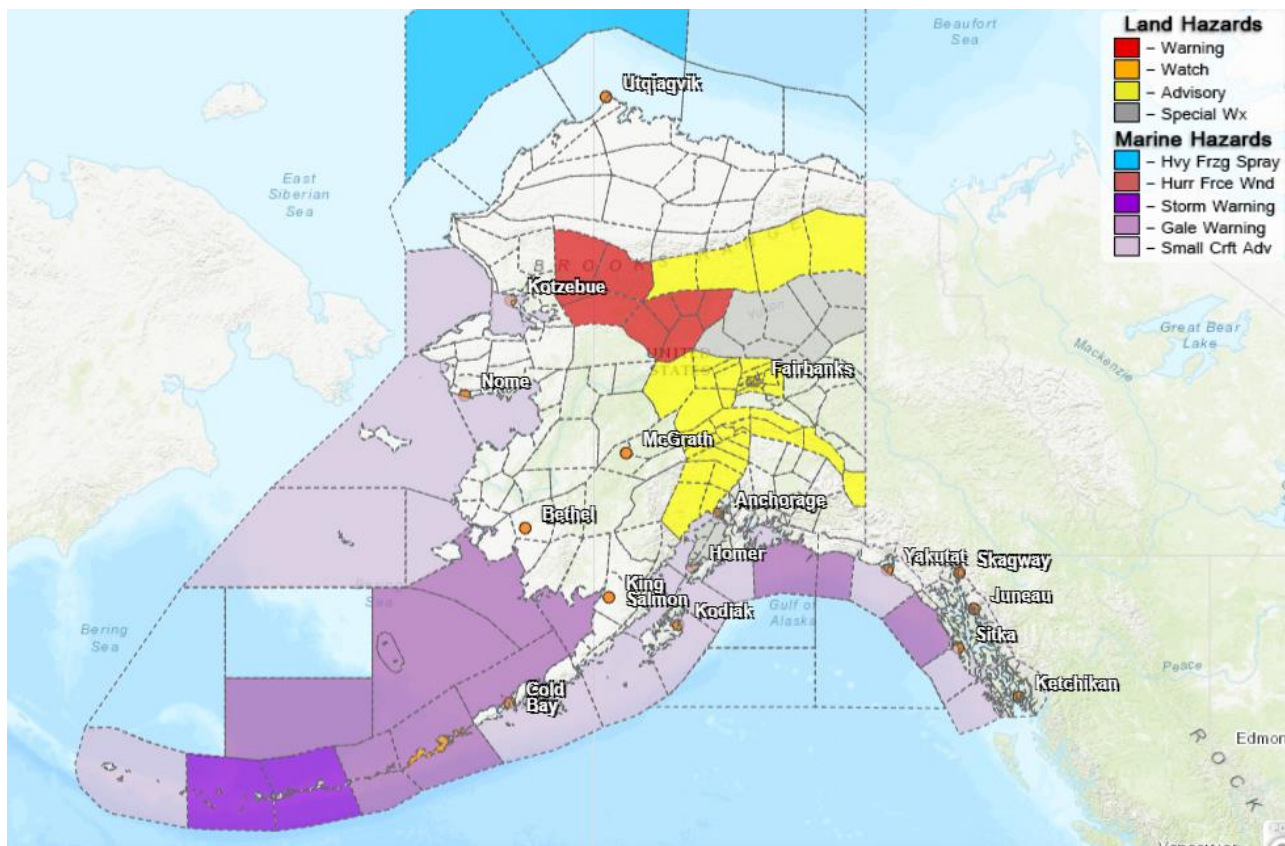

Significant Weather:



Winter Weather Advisories have been issued for the following areas:

- Central Interior, Southeastern Brooks Range, and the Middle Tanana Valley – Up to 8 inches of additional snowfall is possible between now and Friday morning.
- Northern Susitna Valley – Additional snowfall is expected near Broad Pass through Thursday night.

A High Wind Watch has been issued for Unalaska and the Eastern Aleutians for Thursday. 30 to 50 mph winds with gusts to 75 mph are possible.

Wind Advisories have been issued for Denali and the Eastern Alaska Range. Winds 30 to 40 mph with gusts to 65 mph are possible through 6:00 A.M. Thursday.

A Winter Storm Warning for heavy snowfall remains in effect for the Upper Koyukuk, Kobuk, and Noatak Valleys through Thursday night.

A Special Weather Statement remains in effect for the Western Kenai Peninsula. The Skilak Glacier dammed Lake is releasing water, resulting in elevated water levels on Skilak Lake and the Kenai River. The water is expected to crest around bankfull within the next two days, and no flooding is expected.
