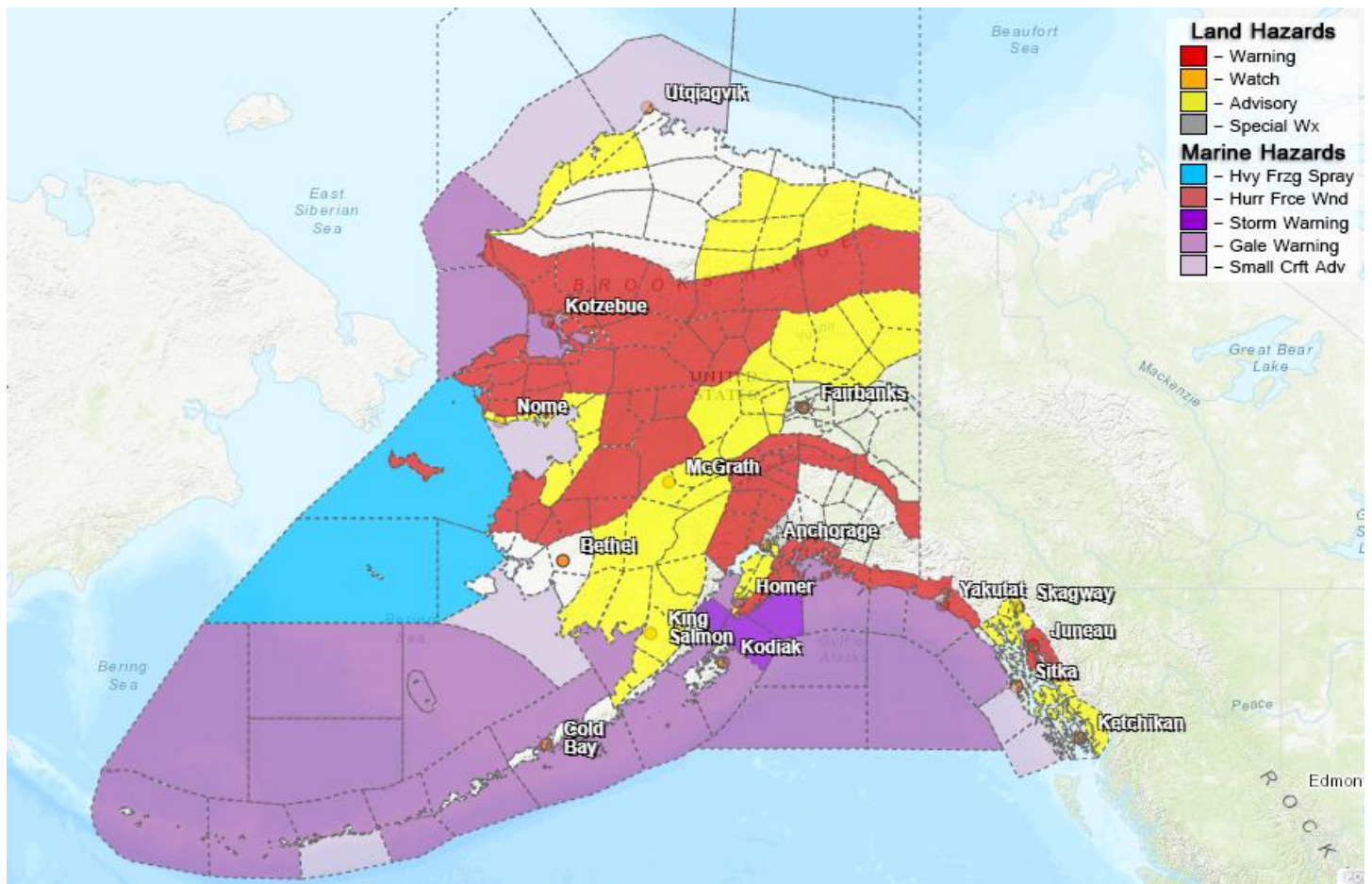

Significant Weather:



Coastal Flood Warnings and Advisories are in effect for much of the western coastline from Point Hope south to Scammon Bay as well as St. Lawrence Island until late tonight. Water levels up to 7 feet above the normal high tide line are possible.

Blizzard Warnings are in effect for the following areas:

- Baldwin Peninsula, Selawik Valley and the northern and interior Seward Peninsula until noon today.
- Chukchi Sea coast and the lower Kobuk and Noatak Valleys until 3:00 P.M. today.

Winter Storm Warnings are in effect for the following areas:

- Yukon, lower Koyukuk, upper Kobuk and Noatak Valleys until 9:00 P.M. today.
- Southeastern Brooks Range and the upper Koyukuk valley until 6:00 A.M. tomorrow.
- Juneau and Yakutat until 9:00 A.M. tomorrow
- Southeast Prince William Sound until noon today, Portage Valley until 6:00 A.M. tomorrow and northeast Prince William Sound until 6:00 P.M. tomorrow.
- Susitna Valley until 5:00 A.M. tomorrow

Winter Weather Advisories are in effect for the following areas:

- Yukon Flats and the eastern Alaska Range until 6:00 P.M. today.
- Upper Kuskokwim Valley, northeastern Brooks Range and the Central Interior until 6:00 A.M. tomorrow.
- Gustavus and Haines from 3:00 P.M. today until 9:00 A.M. tomorrow.
- Petersburg and Wrangell from midnight tonight until noon tomorrow.
- Hyder from midnight tonight until midnight tomorrow night.
- Western Kenai Peninsula south of Clam Gulch until 6:00 P.M. today.
- Anchorage from 1:00 A.M. tonight until 1:00 P.M. tomorrow.
- Bristol Bay until 1:00 A.M. tomorrow.

A High Wind Warning is in effect for Denali and the eastern Alaska Range until midnight tonight. Winds gusting to 70mph are possible.

A Special Weather Statement has been issued for the Matanuska Valley. Snow is expected across the valley from late Monday night into Tuesday morning.
