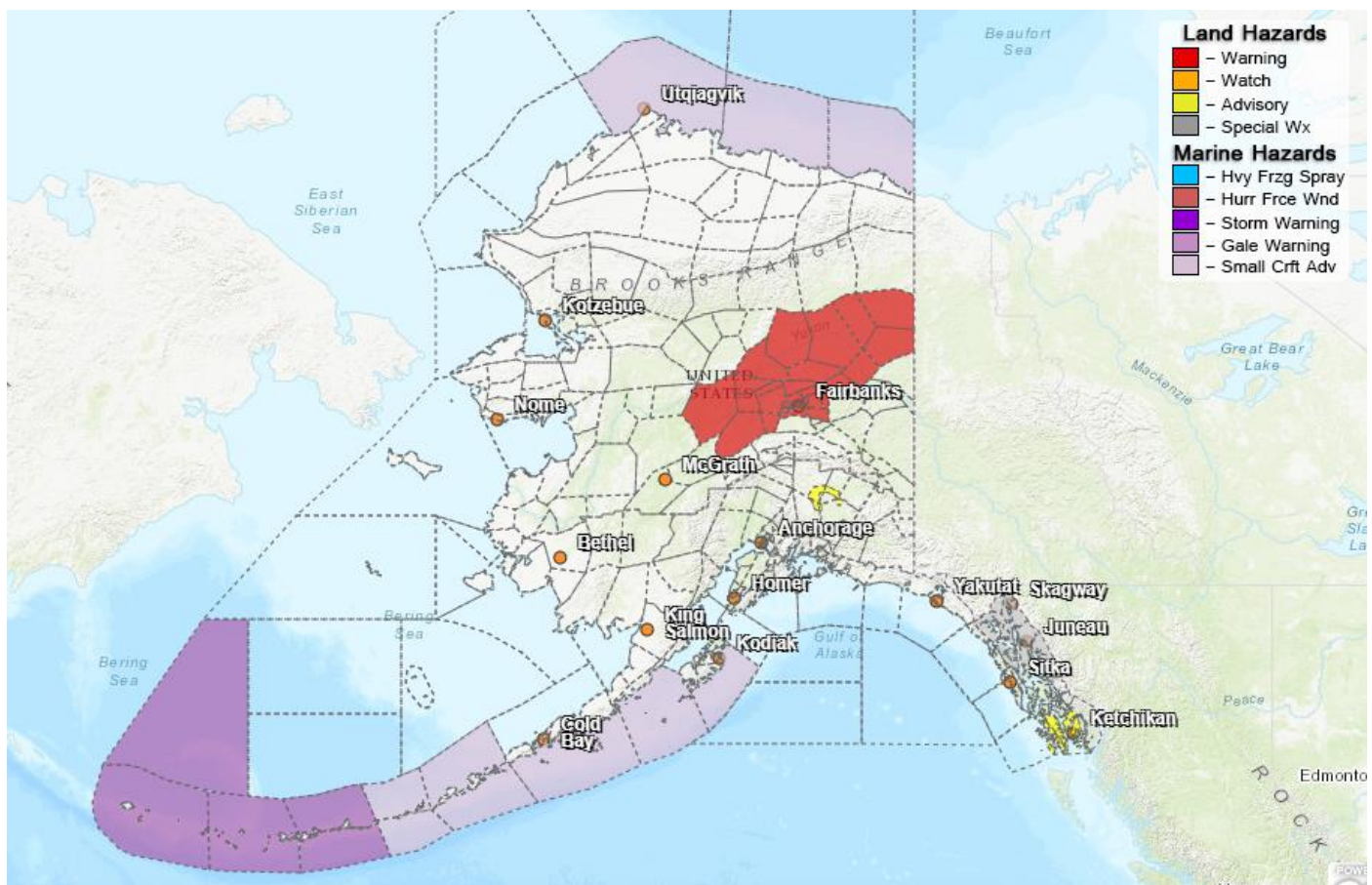

A Flood Advisory remains in effect for the Copper River Basin – Snowmelt flooding continues along the Gulkana River and Lake Louise Road. The advisory expires tomorrow.

### **Fire Weather:**

A Red Flag Warning has been issued for the Central Interior, Middle Tanana Valley and the Yukon Flats from noon to 10:00 P.M. today.

A Special Weather Statement has been issued for much of southeast Alaska for increased fire danger next week due to warm dry conditions.

Burn permits remain suspended for most of south central and the southern interior due to high fire risk conditions.
