## **Significant Issues:**

An explosive eruption of Shishaldin Volcano began around 19:40 AKDT on November 2. Ash was first observed in satellite data at an altitude of 20,000 ft above sea level. This was a decrease in the cloud height from the initial estimate and the National Weather Service modified their SIGMET accordingly. Available data shows the eruption continues at a constant level. The Aviation Color Code and Alert Level remain at ORANGE/WATCH.

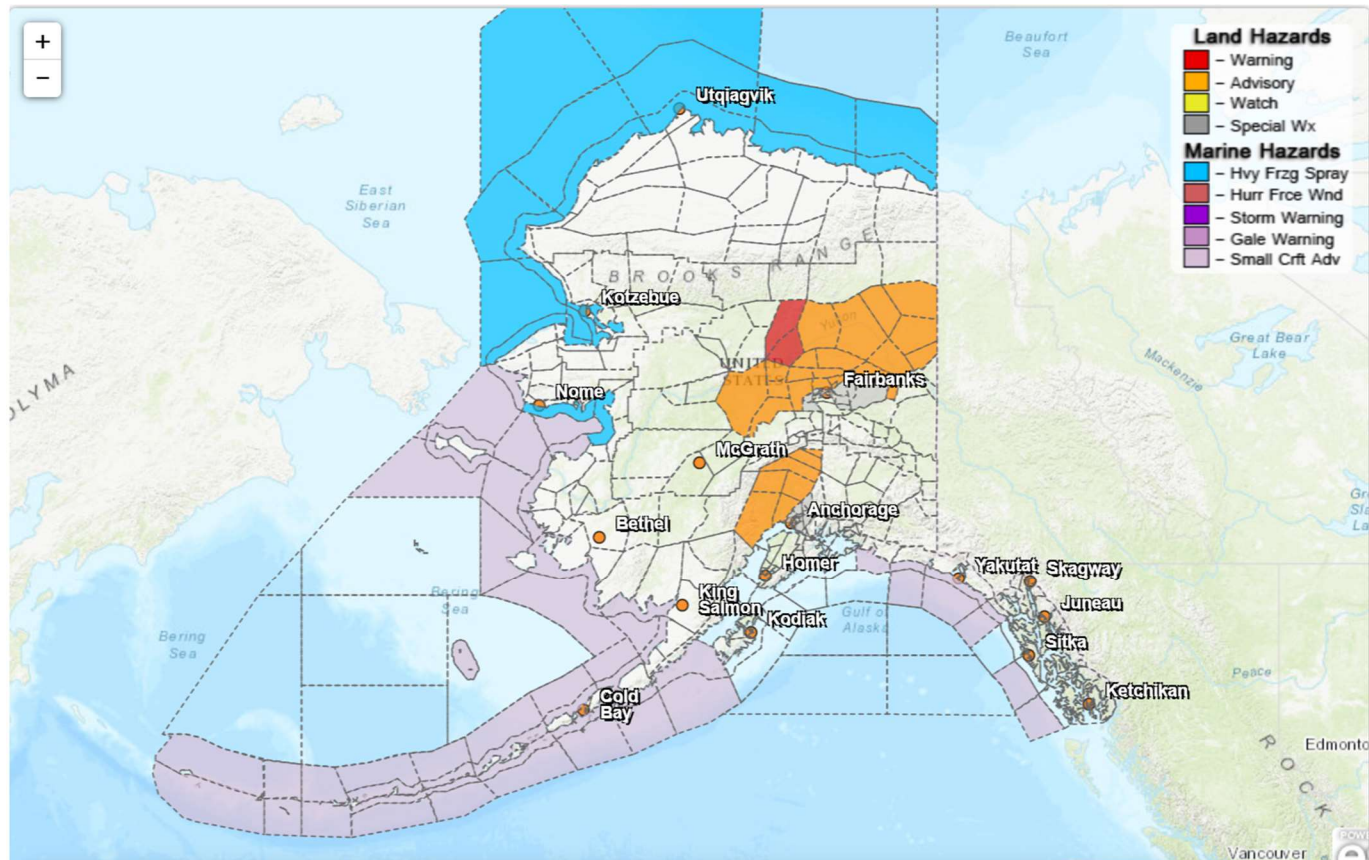

- **Special Weather Statement** in effect for Anchorage North to the Matanuska Valley for patchy ice possible through late morning.
- **Special Weather Statement** in effect for Upper Chena River Valley; Eielson AFB and Salcha; Goldstream Valley and Nenana Hills; Two Rivers; Fairbanks Metro Area and Nenana for blustery winds through Saturday.
- **Winter Weather Advisory** for Susitna Valley remains in effect until 2 PM AKDT today.
- **High Wind Warning** in effect for Dalton Hwy Summits until 7 PM AKDT Saturday.
- **Wind Advisory** in effect for the Central Interior; White Mountains and high terrain South of the Yukon River; Yukon Flats and Chatanika River Valley until 7 PM AKDT Saturday.
