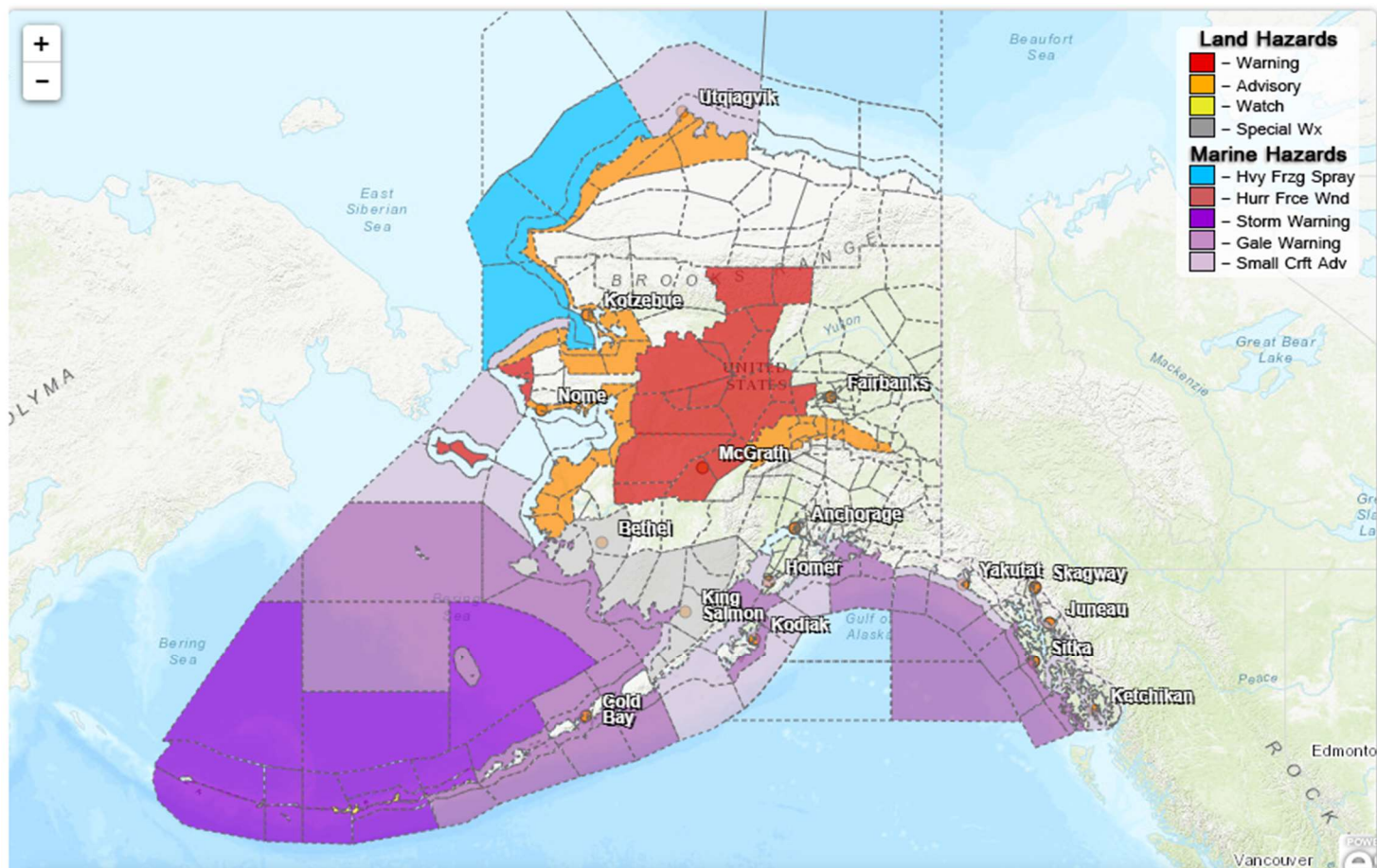

Special Weather Statement:

- **Kuskokwim Delta; Bristol Bay** – strong winds and high surf possible tonight through Wednesday night along the SW coast.

Winter Storm Warnings:

- **Lower Koyukuk Valley; Middle Yukon Valley; Lower Yukon and Innoko Valleys; Upper Kuskokwim Valley** – warning in effect until 3PM AKST Thursday afternoon.
- **South Slopes of The Central Brooks Range; Upper Koyukuk Valley; Central Interior** – warning in effect until 3AM AKST Friday morning.

Blizzard Warning:

- **Northeast Prince William Sound** – warning in effect from 1PM to 9PM AKST today for Thompson Pass.
- **Western Prince William Sound** – warning in effect from 10AM to 4PM AKST today for Whittier.

Wind Advisories:

- **Northern Denali Borough; and Eastern Alaska Range North of Trims Camp** – advisory in effect until 9PM AKST Wednesday night.
