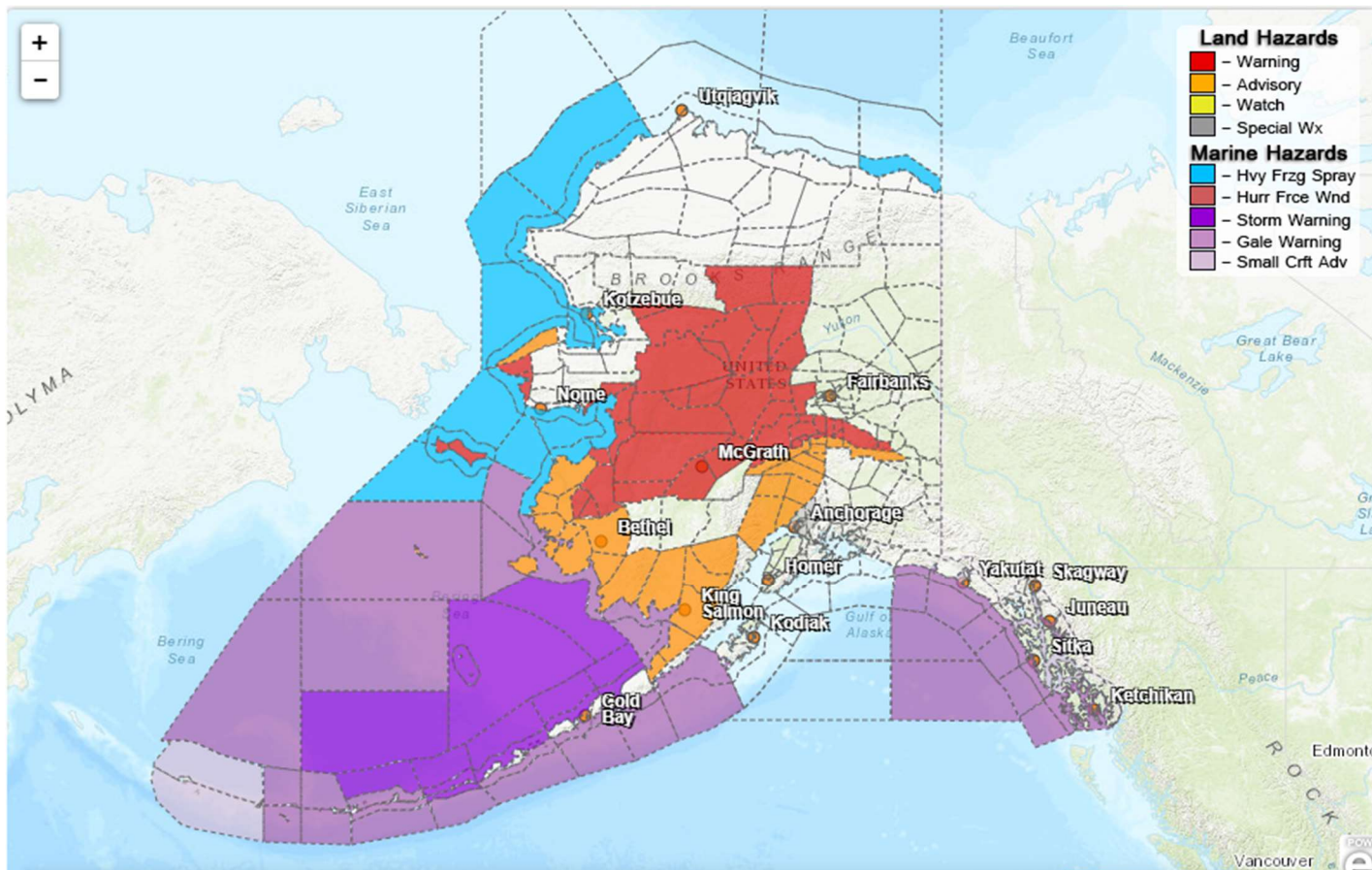

## Special Weather Statement:

- **Anchorage; East Turnagain Arm; Matanuska Valley; Western Kenai Peninsula** – gusty winds and warming temperatures today.
- **Anchorage; Matanuska Valley** – potential for falling tree branches with gusty winds today.

## Winter Storm Warnings:

- **Eastern Norton Sound and Nulato Hills; Upper Kobuk Valleys; Lower Koyukuk Valley; Middle Yukon Valley; Lower Yukon and Innoko Valleys; Upper Kuskokwim Valley; Lower Yukon River** – warning remains in effect until 3PM AKST Thursday afternoon.
- **South Slopes of The Central Brooks Range; Upper Koyukuk Valley; Dalton Highway Summits; Central Interior** – in effect from 9AM this morning to 3AM AKST Friday.

## Winter Weather Advisory:

- **Southern Denali Borough; Eastern Alaska Range South of Trims Camp** – advisory in effect until 3AM AKST Friday.
- **Susitna Valley** – advisory in effect until 5PM AKST Friday.

## High Wind Watch:

- **Central Aleutians** – watch in effect until this morning.

## High Wind Warning:

- **Eastern Alaska Range North of Trims Camp; Northern Denali Borough** – in effect until 9PM AKST tonight.
- **St. Lawrence Island** – warning in effect from midnight tonight until midnight AKST tonight.
- **Bering Strait Coast** – warning in effect until 9AM AKST on Thursday.

## Coastal Flood Advisories:

- **Bristol Bay** – advisory in effect from 11AM this morning to 5AM AKST Thursday.
- **Kuskokwim Delta** – advisory in effect until 4PM AKST this afternoon.
