Significant Issues:

The SEOC has activated to level 2 to support the search and rescue operation in Wrangell and to implement the Governor’s declaration of disaster. The Incident Situation Report for Wrangell is attached. The SEOC is also monitoring other communities in Southeast Alaska that are also starting to report damages to roads and culverts due to landslides.

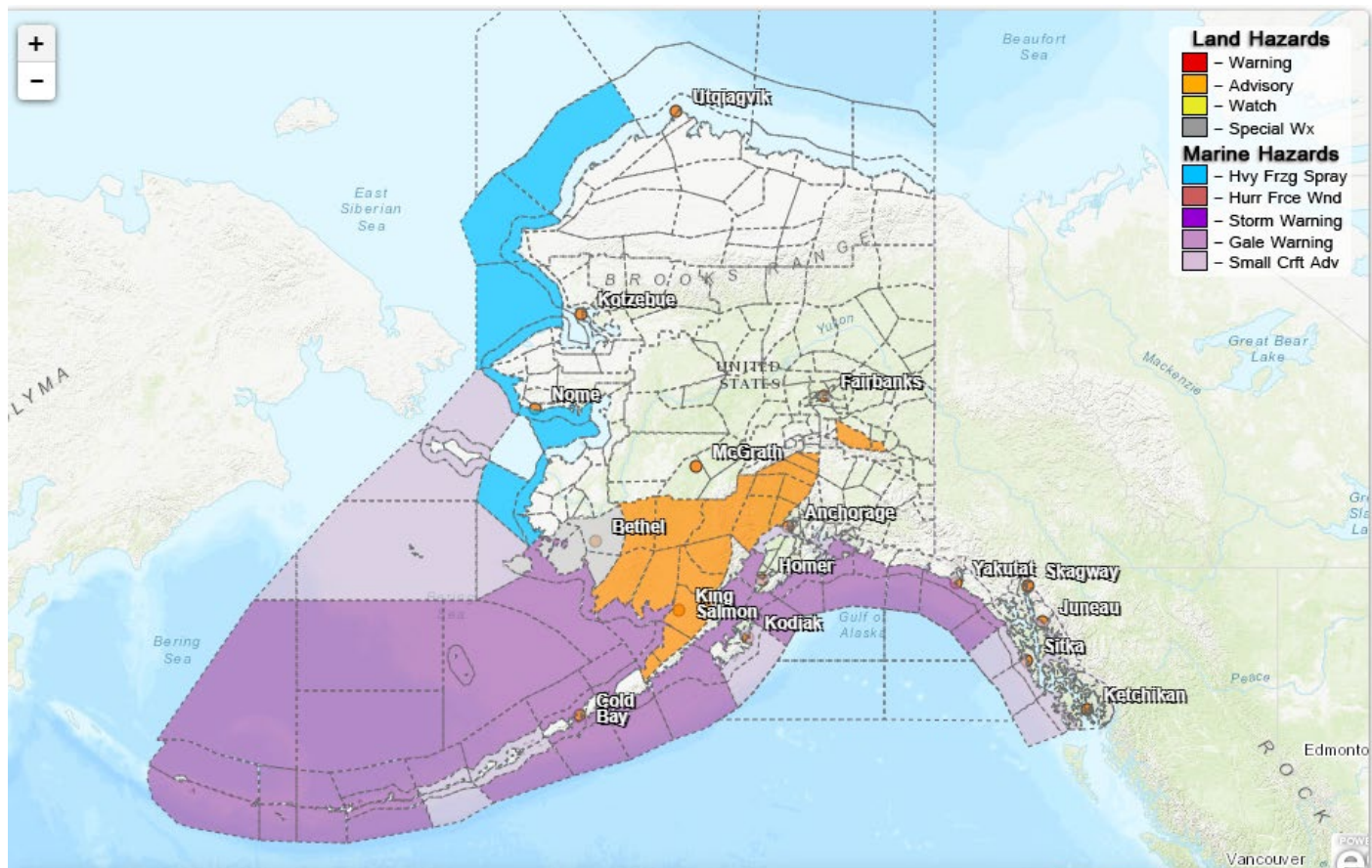
