**Significant Issues:**

SEOC is activated at level 2 and worked through the Thanksgiving weekend supporting Wrangell Landslide search and recovery operations, the community of Coffman Cove, and other statewide incidents. SEOC is implementing Governor Dunleavy’s declaration of disaster for the Wrangell landslide and the disaster incident specific situation report is attached. SEOC will continue with active operational coordination through the weekend, with the next disaster specific situation report to be released today on or before 1600hrs. and then again on Monday November 27, 2023.

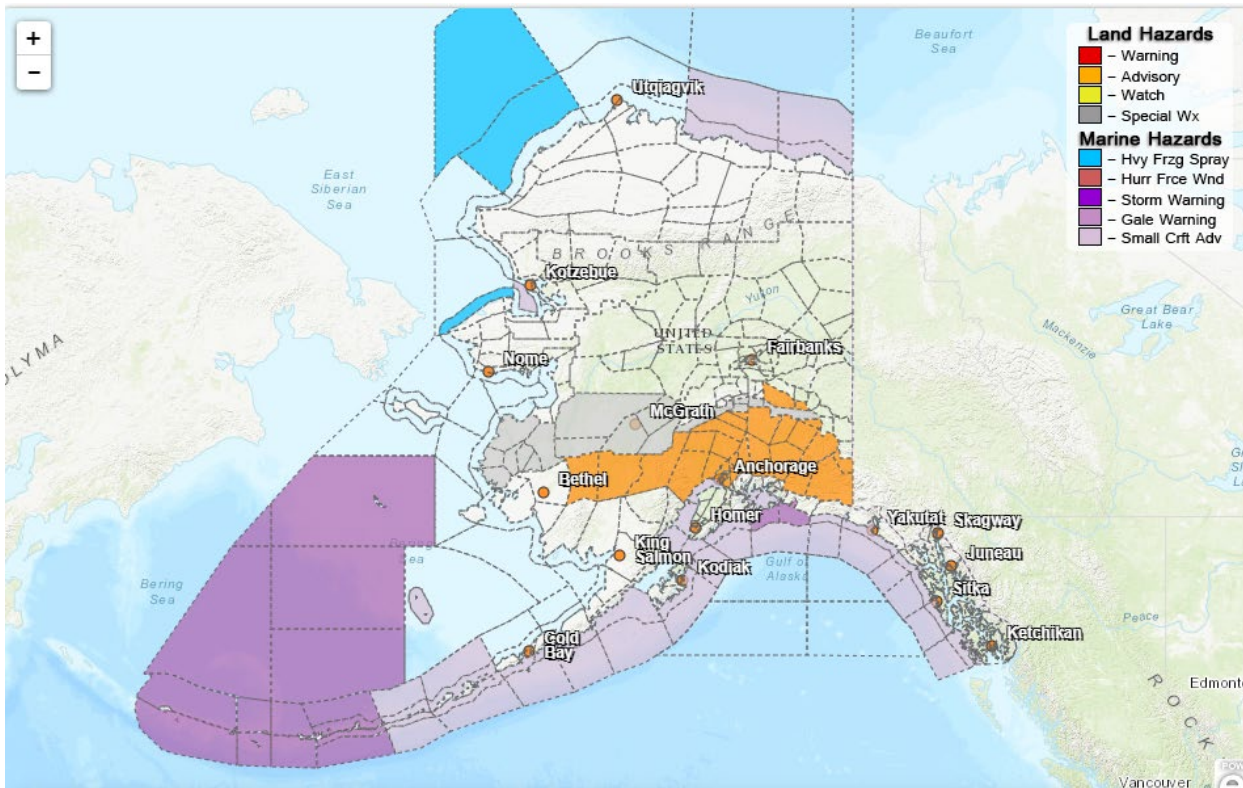
