Significant Issues:

Shishaldin Volcano continues to see variable activity. Over the weekend the advisory level was heightened due to the amount of seismic activity and ash present. Updates were in effect until Sunday afternoon when activity lessened, and advisories were returned to their former levels: Alert Level of Watch; Aviation Color Code of Orange.

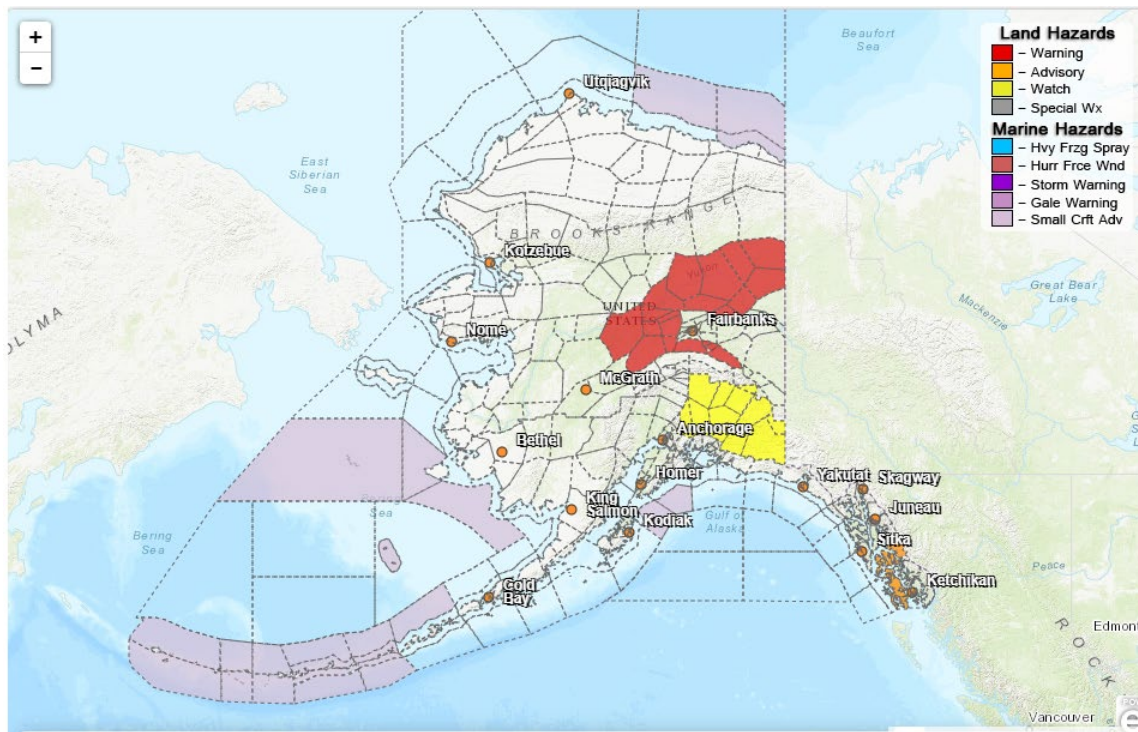
