Kotzebue – Frozen Water Lines

SEOC continues to have a disaster assistance team in Kotzebue to provide the City technical assistance in recovery and cost estimation pursuant to Governor Dunleavy’s declaration of a state disaster for frozen water lines.

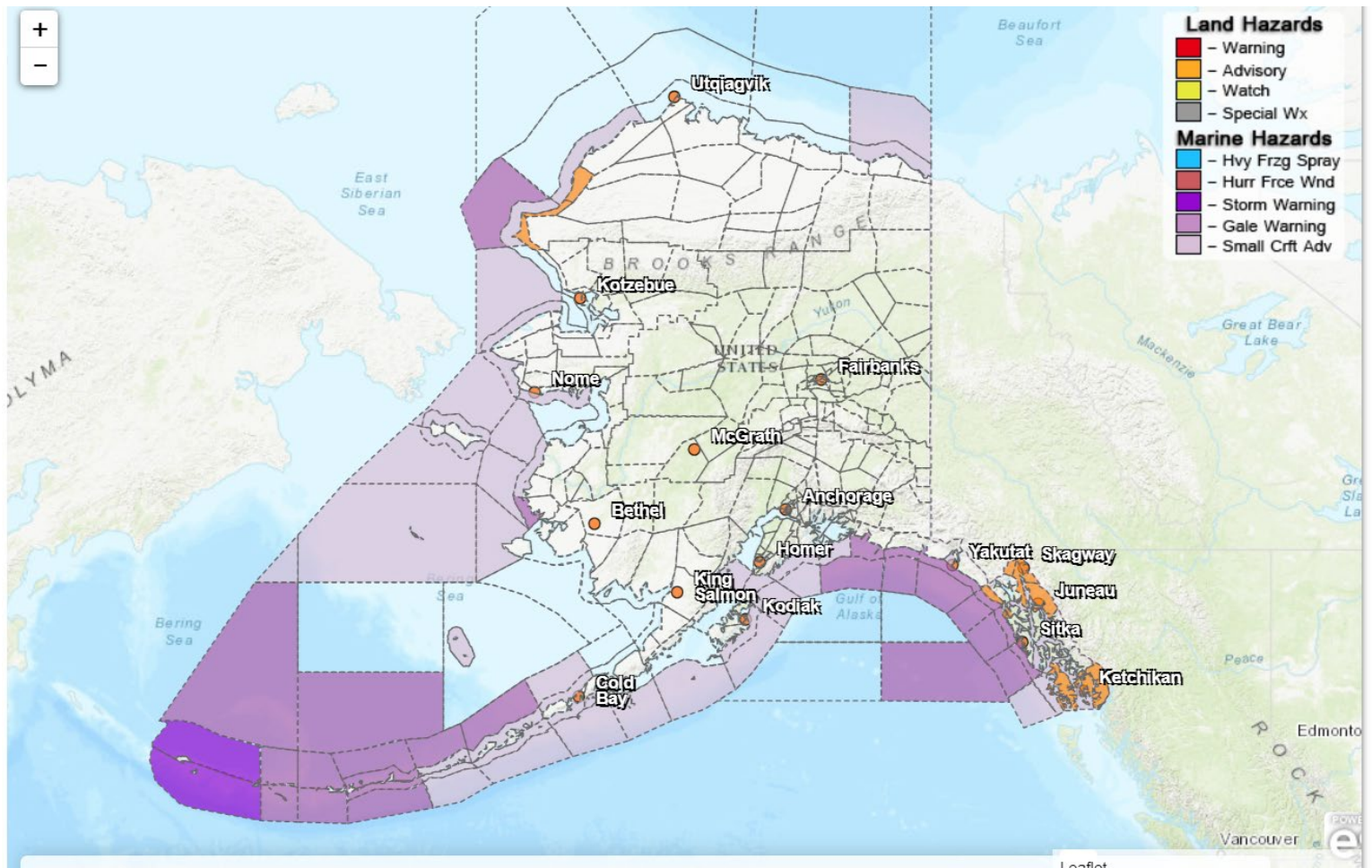
