



Incident Overview:



Incident Outlook:

- No current major flooding. Kuskokwim is predicted to flush out smoothly. Yukon River has some open water along river banks, however ice has not begun to move.
- Flood Watch for Upper/Lower Kalskag expiring 1945 5/7/2018 as water levels have dropped significantly starting last night and into today.
- Ice has not begun to move along Yukon River

Weather is currently being observed in the field to determine flight capabilities.

.DISCUSSION...

The weather focus this week will be warm temperatures, rapid snowpack melting and potential for elevated water levels and ice jams developing on interior rivers this week.

This Afternoon

A 30 percent chance of rain, mainly before 5pm. Partly sunny, with a high near 47. West wind around 5 mph.

Tonight

Partly cloudy, with a low around 28. Calm wind becoming east around 5 mph.

Tuesday

Mostly cloudy, then gradually becoming sunny, with a high near 59. East wind around 5 mph.

Tuesday Night

Mostly clear, with a low around 34. East wind around 5 mph becoming calm in the evening.

Wednesday

Sunny, with a high near 65. Light and variable wind becoming northeast 5 to 10 mph in the afternoon.
