Incident Overview

State Emergency Operations Center (SEOC) Activated to Level 2

Riverwatch 2018 began on 4/30/2018 with the SEOC standing up to a Level 2 Preparedness Level.

Kuskowkim Division is closed for Operational Period 6 due to ice and water moving freely through Bethel.

Upper Yukon Division:

Daily flights monitoring river ice status between Eagle and Circle. Ice is breaking up near Eagle and progressing downstream. Forecasted temperatures in the 60's and 70's will likely speed break-up between Eagle and Circle.



| Eagle At 1310, the SEOC was notified by Yukon Division Supervisor Claude of a houseboat on a sloup Yukon River with two individuals on board, near the Glenn Creek area downstream of Eagle. To located between the Tatonduk River and Nation River. The situation could develop into a Seal Rescue with about fifty miles of ice heading downstream. The houseboat has been in contact and has a radio and is reported to have a satellite phone. More information to fallow once the team flies down the river to Circle.
