



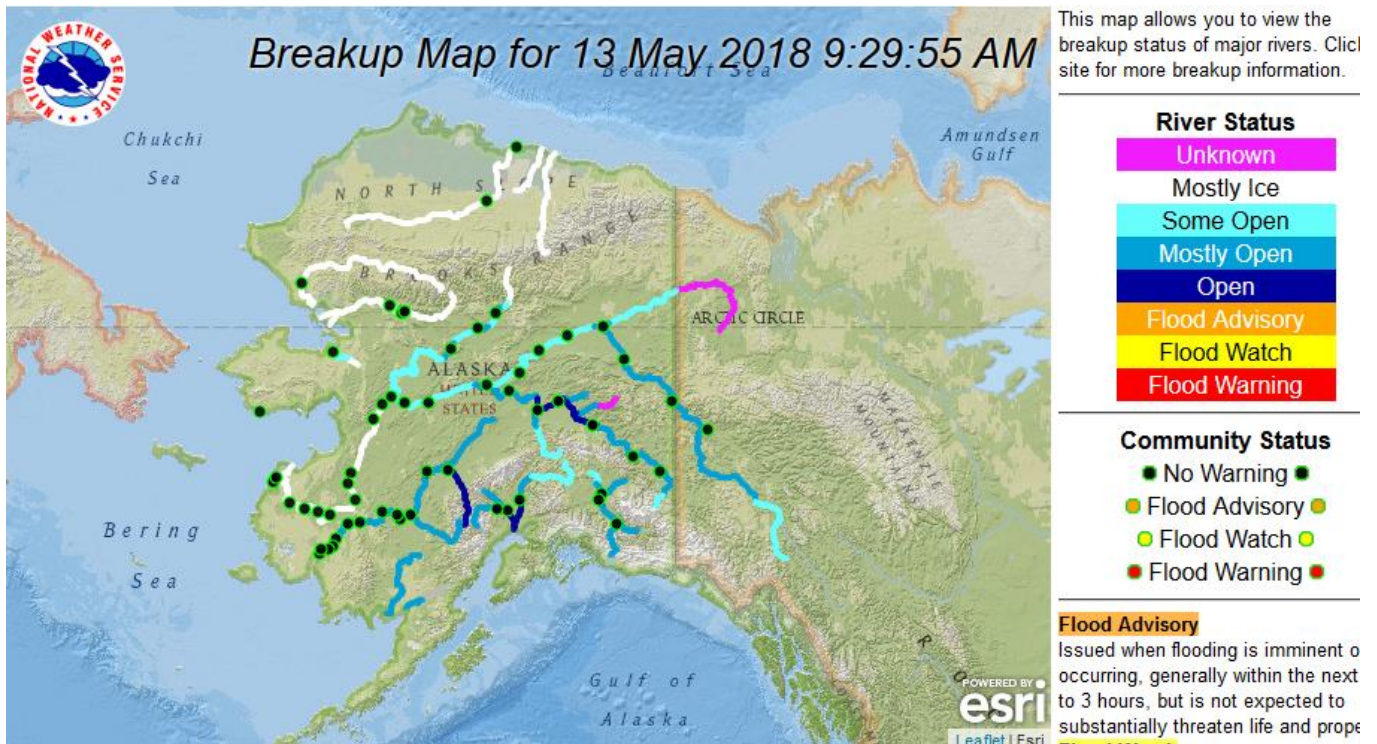

### State Emergency Operations Center (SEOC) Activated to Level 2

Riverwatch 2018 began on 4/30/2018 with the SEOC standing up to a Level 2 Preparedness Level. The SEOC completed operations on 5/14/2018 at 1700hrs. Further operations will be handled by the SEOC operations section.

Middle Yukon Division:

Break up on the Yukon River is approximately 6 miles below Nulato and with the progress of the break up front and the reduced risk to the communities in the area, the SEOC has demobilized the Middle Yukon Division.
