

**River Watch and Spring Breakup:** The Upper Yukon team observed local ice movement in Eagle yesterday afternoon with several open sections of the river upstream of Eagle. The ice between Eagle and Circle continues to degrade and melt in place.

The SEOC is monitoring high water along the Kuskokwim River. The water on the Kuskokwim River released yesterday afternoon letting the water level to recede. Following the release of the Kuskokwim River, the Tulusak River released and the water level is dropping. The SEOC is in regular contact with communities along the Kuskokwim River and is working with Bethel Search and Rescue, and the National Weather Service fallowing this development.
