

The SEOC is aware of two cyber incidents affecting the Matanuska-Susitna Borough and the City of Valdez. The FBI is responding to both events, and both the Alaska Information Analysis Center at the Alaska Department of Public Safety and the Information Security Office at the Alaska Department of Administration are aware and tracking each event.
