

Significant Weather



There are no weather warnings, watches, or advisories issued for Alaska today; however, there is a special weather statement for the Yakutat area because Berg glacier-dammed lake is releasing causing flooding along the Gandil River, Bering River and Bering Lake. Flows are forecast to crest on the Bering River on Thursday or Friday, with overbank flooding persisting along the Bering and Gandil River for 6 or 7 days. Total rise at Bering Lake due to this glacier dammed lake release is approximately 9 feet.
