
Whittier Breakwater Damage

Kenai Peninsula Borough Flooding

The Kenai Peninsula Borough (KPB) continues to evaluate the impacts of their recent flooding near Seward. The SEOC is in regular communication with the Borough and involved State and Federal agencies. A joint (FEMA/State) preliminary damage assessment teams are scheduled to travel to KPB and Seward Thursday this week.

A Winter Storm Warning is in effect for the Lower Kobuk and Noatak Valleys from 7 am this morning until 10 pm Thursday. The Winter Storm Warning for Chukchi Sea Coast is in effect from 7 am this morning until 4 PM AKDT Thursday.

A winter weather advisory is in effect for the Western Arctic Coast from 10 am this morning to 10 pm this evening.
