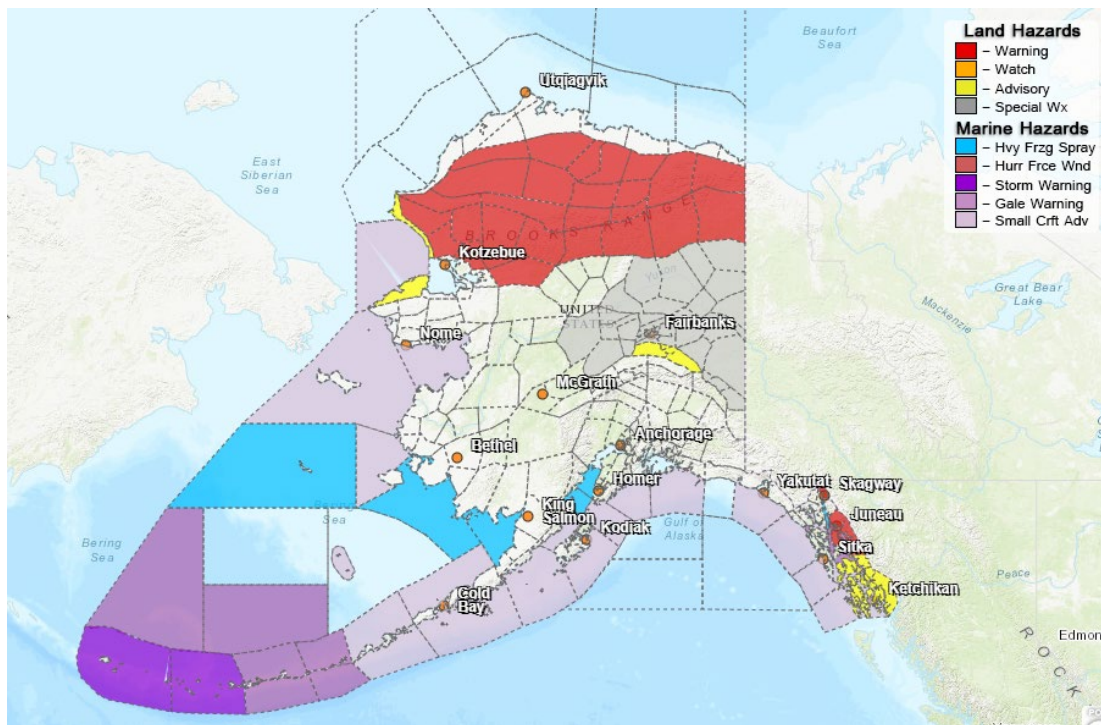
Diomedes Power Supply
