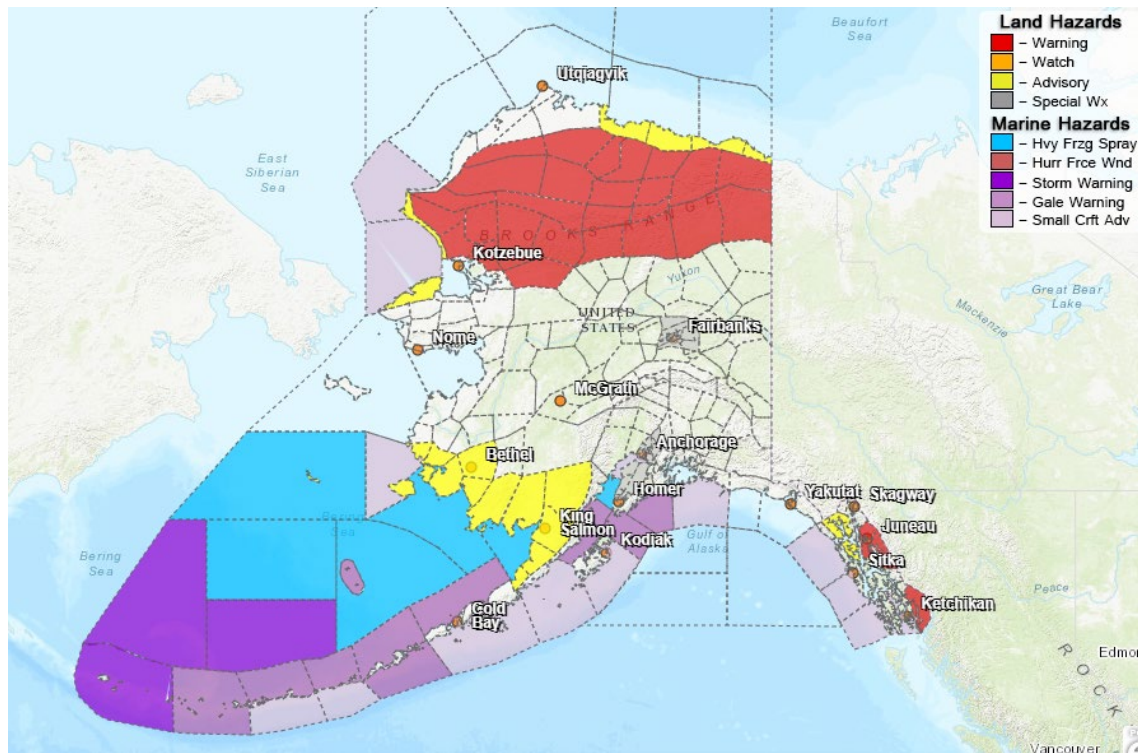
Thorne Bay Landslide
