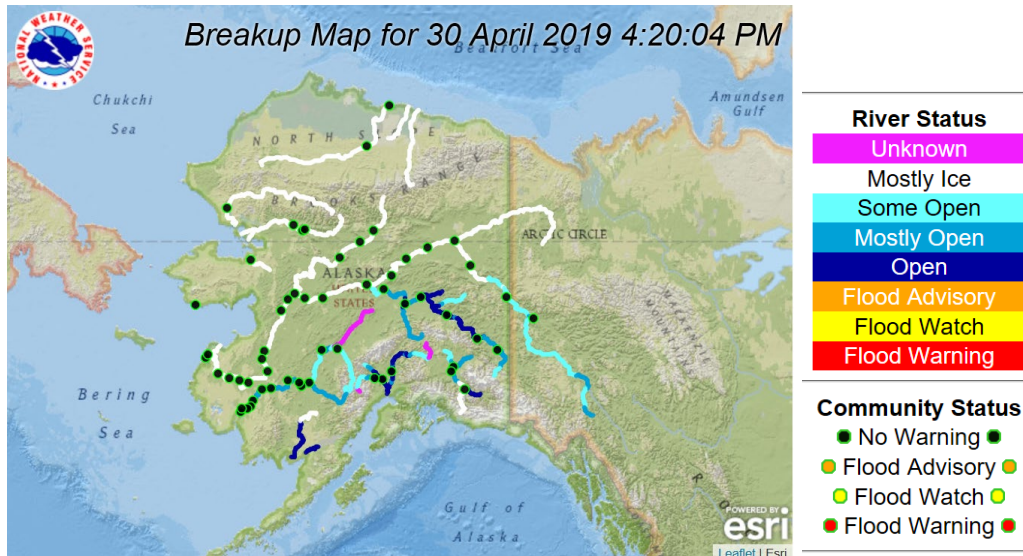
**Cook Inlet M7.1 Earthquake (FEMA Declaration 4413-DR)**

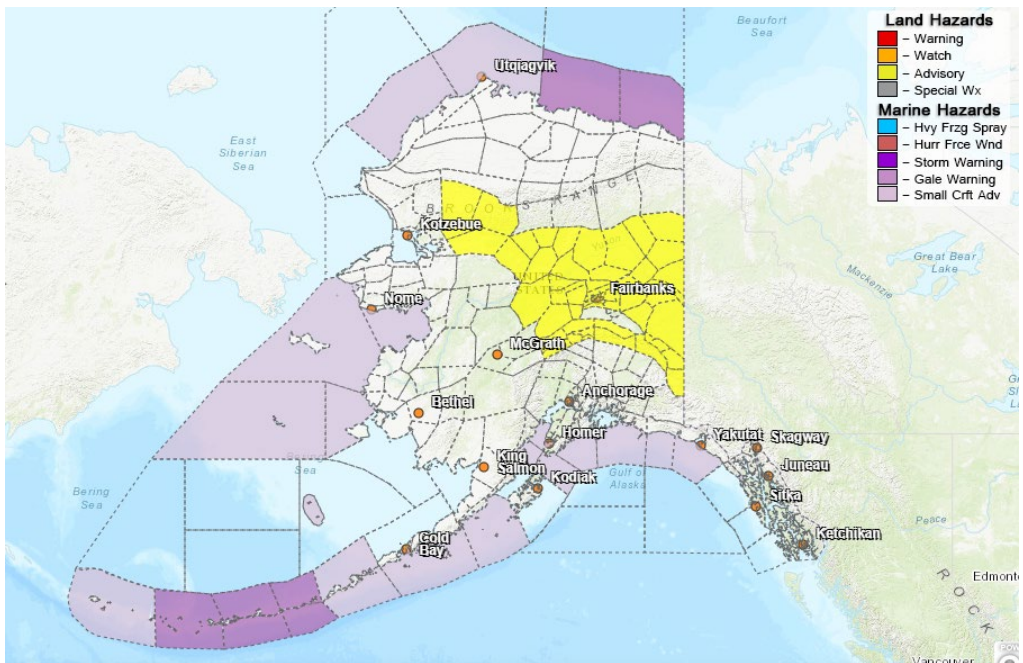
**Riverwatch 2019:** The Riverwatch teams for the Kuskokwim River and the Upper Yukon are demobilized. The Middle Yukon team will deploy early next week. No significant breakup issues have been reported so far.



Breakup of the state’s major rivers continues. Even though a particular river or reach may be described as mostly open or open. It is still possible for runs of ice and debris to move through as headwaters upstream breakup. Please use caution at all times when attempting to navigate rivers.
