Wildland Fires

SEOC was notified yesterday by the Small Business Administration (SBA) that they have issued a Disaster Declaration for the McKinley Fire. SEOC is coordinating with the SBA for the opening of a Disaster Loan Outreach Center (DLOC) in Talkeetna at fire station 11-2 located at 42488 South Parks Highway Talkeetna, Ak 99676, which is scheduled to open on Thursday, October 3, at 1 PM. The SBA plans to operate the DLOC through Thursday, October 17. Applicants may also apply online at https://disasterloan.sba.gov/ela



Significant Weather:



Coastal Flood watch is in effect from Thursday evening through Saturday evening for the following areas: St. Lawrence Island, Bering Strait Coast, Southern Seward Peninsula, Eastern Norton Sound, and the Yukon Delta.

Winter Storm Watches are in effect Thursday evening through late Friday night for heavy snow forecasted for the Upper Kobuk and Noatak Valleys, and the Southeastern Brooks Range. Total snow accumulations of 8-12 inches with localized areas reaching up to 14 inches.

Winter Weather Advisories are in effect until midnight tonight for snowfall at higher elevations of the central and eastern Interior, Denali, and the Eastern Alaska Range. Total snow accumulations of 3-5 inches with localized amounts up to 7 inches.
