Wildland Fires

SEOC was notified October 1, 2019 by the Small Business Administration (SBA) that they have issued a Disaster Declaration for the McKinley Fire. SEOC is coordinating with the SBA for the opening of a Disaster Loan Outreach Center (DLOC) in Talkeetna at fire station 11-2 located at 42488 South Parks Highway Talkeetna, Ak 99676, which is scheduled to open on Thursday, October 3, at 1 PM. The SBA plans to operate the DLOC through Thursday, October 17. Applicants may also apply online at https://disasterloan.sba.gov/ela

Application for State Disaster Individual Assistance remains available online through October 22, 2019.



Significant Weather:



Several Coastal Flood Warnings have been issued for Norton Sound, the Seward Peninsula, the Lower Yukon Delta, in effect from Friday morning through Sunday morning. Water levels up to 10 feet above normal high tide and coastal erosion are likely.

Several Winter Storm Warnings have been issued for the Kobuk and Noatak Valleys and extending eastward through the Upper Koyokuk Valley and Southeastern Brooks Range, in effect from this afternoon through Saturday morning for heavy snow.

Several Winter Weather Advisories have been issued for the central and eastern Interior, including Denali, the Tanana Valley, Yukon Flats, Fortymile Country, and associated uplands, for snowfall occurring now through tonight.

Coastal Flood Advisories have been issued for Saint Lawrence Island, Baldwin Peninsula, selawik Valley, Chukchi Sea Coast, and the Bering Strait Coast, in effect from Friday morning through Sunday morning. Water levels up to 5 feet above normal high tide and coastal erosion are likely.

A Special Weather Statement is in effect for coastal areas between Newtok and Hooper Bay for possible coastal erosion from Thursday night through Saturday morning.

A Dense Fog Advisory is in effect for the Deltana and Tanana Flats as well as the middle Tanana Valley until noon today.
