

Significant Weather:



A wind advisory is in effect for Deltana and Tanana Flats, Eastern Alaska Range, Lower Koyukuk and Middle Yukon Valleys, and the Upper Kobuk and Noatak Valleys.

A winter weather advisory is currently in effect for Northeastern Brooks Range, Eastern Beaufort Sea Cost, Kuskokwim Delta, Central Interior, Upper Koyukuk Valley, Yukon Flats and Surrounding Uplands, Eastern Norton Sound and Nulato Hills, Lower Yukon Valley, Northern and Interior Seward Peninsula, Southern Seward Peninsula Coast, and the Yukon Delta.

A high wind warning is in effect for Denali, Anchorage, Western Prince William Sound, and the Upper Kuskokwim Valley.

A winter storm warning is in effect for the St. Lawrence Island and Bering Strait Coast.
