- 3/11 Governor Dunleavy declares a Public Health Disaster Emergency.
- 3/14 Governor Dunleavy announces the first confirmed case of COVID-19 in Alaska.
- 3/20 Governor Dunleavy announces Alaska COVID-19 Economic Stabilization Plan
- 3/25 First out-of-state death of an Alaska resident reported in Washington.
- 3/27 First in-state death of an Alaska resident reported in Anchorage.
- 3/28 Case count in the state exceeds 100.
- 4/7 Case count in the state exceeds 200.
- 4/9 President Trump approves a major disaster declaration for Alaska.
- 4/16 Case count in the state exceeds 300.
- 5/20 Case count in the state exceeds 400.
- 6/3 Case count in the state exceeds 500.
- 6/11 Case count in the state exceeds 600.
- 6/18 Case count in the state exceeds 700.
- 6/22 Case count in the state exceeds 750.

HM10 requires interstate and international travelers, (resident, worker, visitor) to quarantine for 14 days. In addition to the quarantine order, travelers have the option to provide proof of a molecular PCR test that may reduce the time travelers must quarantine for. Interior

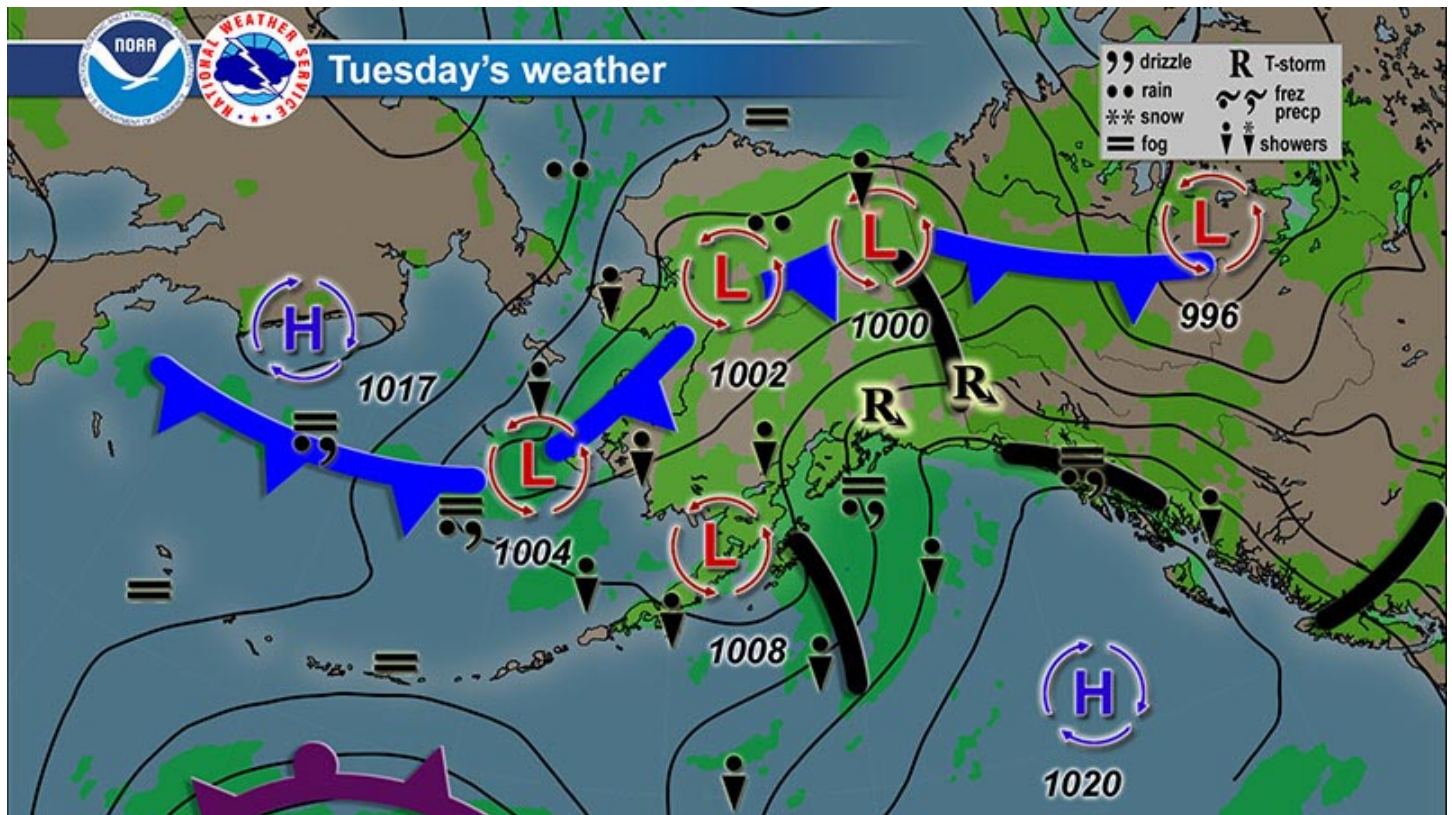
- Afternoon thunderstorms. Flood Watch over eastern Interior.
