HM 10: International and Interstate Travel (Updated: 8/6/20) Alaska's new travel protocols took effect Tuesday, Aug. 11. All non-residents must arrive with a negative COVID-19 PCR test taken within 72 hours prior to departure or proof of a pending test result from a test taken within 72 hours prior to departure.

Interior


• Showers, more numerous in the afternoon. rs. Isolated evening T-storms. Areas of MVFR E. Interior, some morning fog in the valleys

Northern

• Patchy fog, low ceilings and poor visibility along the coast. Some clearing in the afternoon. LIFR along the coast, IFR otherwise with improvements to MVFR or VFR in the afternoons.

Southeast

• Showers on Thursday turning to rain on Friday and continuing thru the weekend. Locally heavy rain southern end. MVFR/VFR turning to IFR Friday.
