NTAS BULLETIN: On January 4, 2020, Acting Secretary of Homeland Security Chad F. Wolf issued a new National Terrorism Advisory System (NTAS) Bulletin pertaining to the changing threat landscape following the successful U.S.-led airstrike in Iraq that eliminated Qaseem Soleimani, the head of the Iranian Revolutionary Guard Corps-Quds Force, a U.S.-designated Foreign Terrorist Organization.

A stage 2 air quality alert is in place for the North Pole Zone through noon on Thursday. Clearing skies this afternoon will allow for a shallow inversion to develop late evening into the morning. We are forecasting the North Pole air quality to remain *Unhealthy for Sensitive Groups*.



A high wind warning is in effect for the Juneau Borough and Northern Admiralty Island, and the Haines Borough and Lynn Canal.

A wind chill advisory is in place for the Haines Borough and Lynn Canal, Taiya Inlet and Klondike Highway, Eastern Alaska Range, Central Interior, Deltana and Tanana Flats, Upper Tanana Valley and the Fortymile Country, Upper Koyukuk Valley, and the Yukon Flats and Surrounding Uplands.

A blizzard warning is in effect for the St. Lawrence Island and Bering Strait Coast.
