NTAS BULLETIN: On January 4, 2020, Acting Secretary of Homeland Security Chad F. Wolf issued a new National Terrorism Advisory System (NTAS) Bulletin pertaining to the changing threat landscape following the successful U.S.-led airstrike in Iraq that eliminated Qaseem Soleimani, the head of the Iranian Revolutionary Guard Corps-Quds Force, a U.S.-designated Foreign Terrorist Organization.



A Wind Chill Warning remains in effect until 6:00 pm AKST Wednesday for Northeast Alaska from Anaktuvuk Pass to Kaktovik.

A Special Weather Statement has been Issued for a significant low-pressure system to impact Gulf of Alaska and Southeast Alaska Tuesday and Wednesday.

Wind Chill Advisories remain in effect through 6:00 pm AKST Wednesday for much of Alaska to include Eastern Norton Sound and Nulato Hills, St Lawrence Island and Bering Strait Coast, Yukon Delta, Lower Yukon Valley, Upper Kobuk and Noatak Valleys, Denali, Eastern Alaska Range, Yukon

Flats and Surrounding Uplands, Central Interior, Central Beaufort Sea Coast, Northeastern Brooks Range, Cape Fairweather to Cape Suckling Coastal Area, Kuskokwim Delta, Bristol Bay.

A Blizzard Warning remains in effect until 6:00 pm AKST this evening for Thompson Pass.

A Winter Storm Watch remains in effect for Taiya Inlet and Klondike Highway, Haines Borough and Lynn Canal, including the cities of Skagway and Haines, until 6:00 pm.
