

A Winter Storm Warning is in effect until 6pm Wednesday for St. Lawrence Island and the Bering Strait Coast. A Wind Chill Advisory is in effect until 6pm Wednesday for the Upper and Lower Kobuk and Noatak Valleys, the Northern and Interior Seward Peninsula.

Wind Chill Warning and Wind Chill Advisories are in effect until 6pm Wednesday for the central and Eastern Beaufort Sea Coast.

Winter Weather Advisories in effect until 6am Friday for the Upper Koyukuk Valley and Central Interior.
