

Winter Storm Warnings and Winter Weather Advisories in affect until 9:00pm this evening in Yakutat and along the Southeast panhandle.

Wind Chill Warnings and Wind Chill Advisories in effect until 6:00pm Wednesday for the Central and Eastern Beaufort Sea Coast.

Winter Weather Advisories in effect until Wednesday afternoon for the Kenai Peninsula, Whittier, and the Copper River Basin.

Wind Chill Advisories in effect until 10:00am Thursday for the Kuskokwim Delta region.

Wind Chill Advisories in effect until 6:00pm Wednesday for St. Lawrence Island, Bering Strait Coast, and Chukchi Sea Coast.
