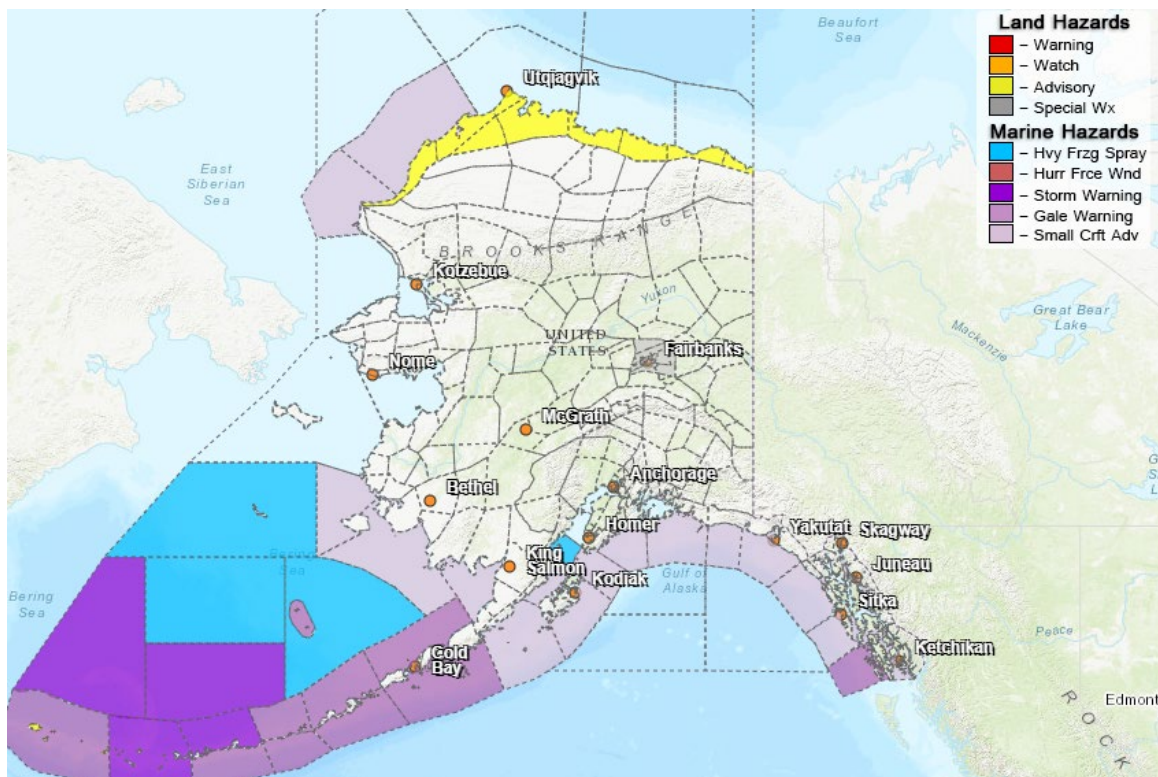

A Special Weather Statement has been issued for cold temperatures next week for Central Interior, Deltana and Tanana Flats, Denali, Eastern Alaska Range, Middle Tanana Valley, Upper Tanana Valley and the Fortymile Country. A Winter Weather Advisory Remains in effect for the Western Aleutians from Friday afternoon through noon Sunday. A Winter Storm Watch is in effect for the

Western Aleutians and Winter Weather Advisories for Western and Northern Arctic Coasts, and Eastern and Central Beaufort Sea Coasts into Saturday morning.

**Turnagain Pass:** Avalanche Hazard is Moderate at all elevations.
