#### Significant Weather:




A special weather statement has been issued for moderate to heavy rain expected to impact the Anchorage Bowl, Mat-Su Valleys, and Kenai Peninsula today. An unusual weather pattern has setup for Southcentral Alaska for early July resulting in a potent storm system set to impact the region today into tonight. The main impacts will be moderate rain for the MAT-SU valleys and the Anchorage Bowl with moderate to heavy rain expected for the Anchorage Hillside to the northern Kenai Peninsula (Cooper Landing, Moose Pass, Seward and Sterling Highways). Rainfall amounts will generally be between 0.5 and 1 inch with some locations along the Seward Highway exceeding 1 inch. Localized ponding on roadways and quick rises in area rivers and streams will also be likely with this storm.
