Significant Issues

Delta River Flooding

The Delta River continues to flow over and around Spengler Road near Delta. Two adjacent "lakes" of flooded gravel pits now are part of the river system. DOT&PF plans to send personnel and equipment to work out a way to reduce river flow and dewater the ponds. The SEOC continues to work with DOT&PF and other state and federal agencies to identify a long-term solution and to identify potential funding sources.

Coronavirus (COVID-19) Pandemic

A unified command has been established at the SEOC. The SEOC Preparedness Level remains at Level 3 for this event.

2020 Fire Season

The Alaska Interagency Coordination Center, (AICC) is at Preparedness Level 1.

Wildland fire totals for 2020:

Total Fires = 309

Total Acres = 178.501

There are currently 51 active fires with 1 fire currently staffed.


Significant Weather:
