Significant Issues

Chignik 7.8 Earthquake

Local damage assessments continue in several communities affected by the M7.8 earthquake last week. DOT&PF has inspected transportation and dock facilities in several communities. Aftershocks from the earthquake will continue to occur for several weeks or months.

Delta River Flooding

DOT&PF continues to develop plans to address the flooding of Spengler Road, near Delta. The National Weather Service has installed a temporary hydrograph station on the road. For the past several days, the water level on the road has remained between 8 and 10 inches deep. It can be monitored at: https://water.weather.gov/ahps2/hydrograph.php?gage=epya2&wfo=pafg. When the water level drops below the road, DOT&PF will assess any damage to the roadway.

Coronavirus (COVID-19) Pandemic

A unified command has been established at the SEOC. The SEOC Preparedness Level remains at Level 3 for this event.

2020 Fire Season

The Alaska Interagency Coordination Center, (AICC) is at Preparedness Level 1.

Wildland fire totals for 2020:

Total Fires = 315

Total Acres = 180,176

There are currently 47 active fires with 0 fires currently staffed.



Significant Weather:




A wind advisory is in effect for Denali and the Eastern Alaska Range until 11 PM this evening.
