#### **Significant Issues**

#### 2020 Fall Sea Storms

Over the weekend, the first strong sea storm of the season impacted the eastern Aleutians and the Alaska Peninsula. The National Weather Service issued multiple high wind warnings and coastal flood advisories. The SEOC has not received any reports of serious damage. The SEOC will continue to monitor the situation today as the storm weakens and moves inland over southcentral Alaska.

#### Coronavirus (COVID-19) Pandemic

A unified command has been established at the SEOC. The SEOC continues to support statewide response to COVID-19.

#### State of Alaska Department of Health and Social Services (DHSS)

DHSS is operating as the Medical Branch under the State EOC/Unified Command.



A Coastal Flood Advisory for Bristol Bay remains in effect until 0900 today.

Wind Advisories are in effect today for the Alaska Range passes near Denali, Deltana and Tanana Flats, and eastern Alaska Range.

A Flood Watch is in effect from 1300 today through Tuesday afternoon for rivers and streams which drain the Talkeetna Mountains in the Matanuska Valley and Susitna Valley.
