

#### Significant Weather:



A Winter Weather Advisory is in effect for the following areas:

- Northeast Gulf Coast including Yakutat, until 3:00 P.M. today. Total snow accumulations
  of 4 to 7 inches are expected.
- Juneau, Douglas, & Angoon until 9:00 P.M. today. Total snow accumulations of 3 to 5 inches are expected.
- Eastern Chichagof Island & Tenakee Springs until midnight tonight. Total snow accumulations of 3 to 5 inches are expected.
- YK Delta, Bristol Bay, & St. Lawrence Island until 3:00 P.M. tomorrow. Snow and sleet is expected with total accumulations of 4 to 10 inches across the area.

A High Wind Warning is in effect for Thompson Pass & Northeast Prince William Sound until 10:00 P.M. today. Northeast winds of 35 to 55 mph with gusts to 75 mph are expected.

The majority of the state is under either a wind chill advisory or warning through tomorrow afternoon. Wind chills of up to 65° below zero are possible in some areas across the state.
