Tuluksak Washeteria Fire:

The SEOC along with multiple state, federal and tribal organizations is continuing to assist the community of Tuluksak in support of recovery efforts. The Yukon-Kuskokwim Health Corporation has remote maintenance workers in the community establishing a temporary watering point and the SEOC is coordinating assistance from DOT&PF to assist with this project.

Coronavirus (COVID-19) Pandemic:

A unified command has been established at the SEOC. The SEOC continues to support statewide response to COVID-19.

DHSS is operating as the Medical Branch under the State EOC/Unified Command.

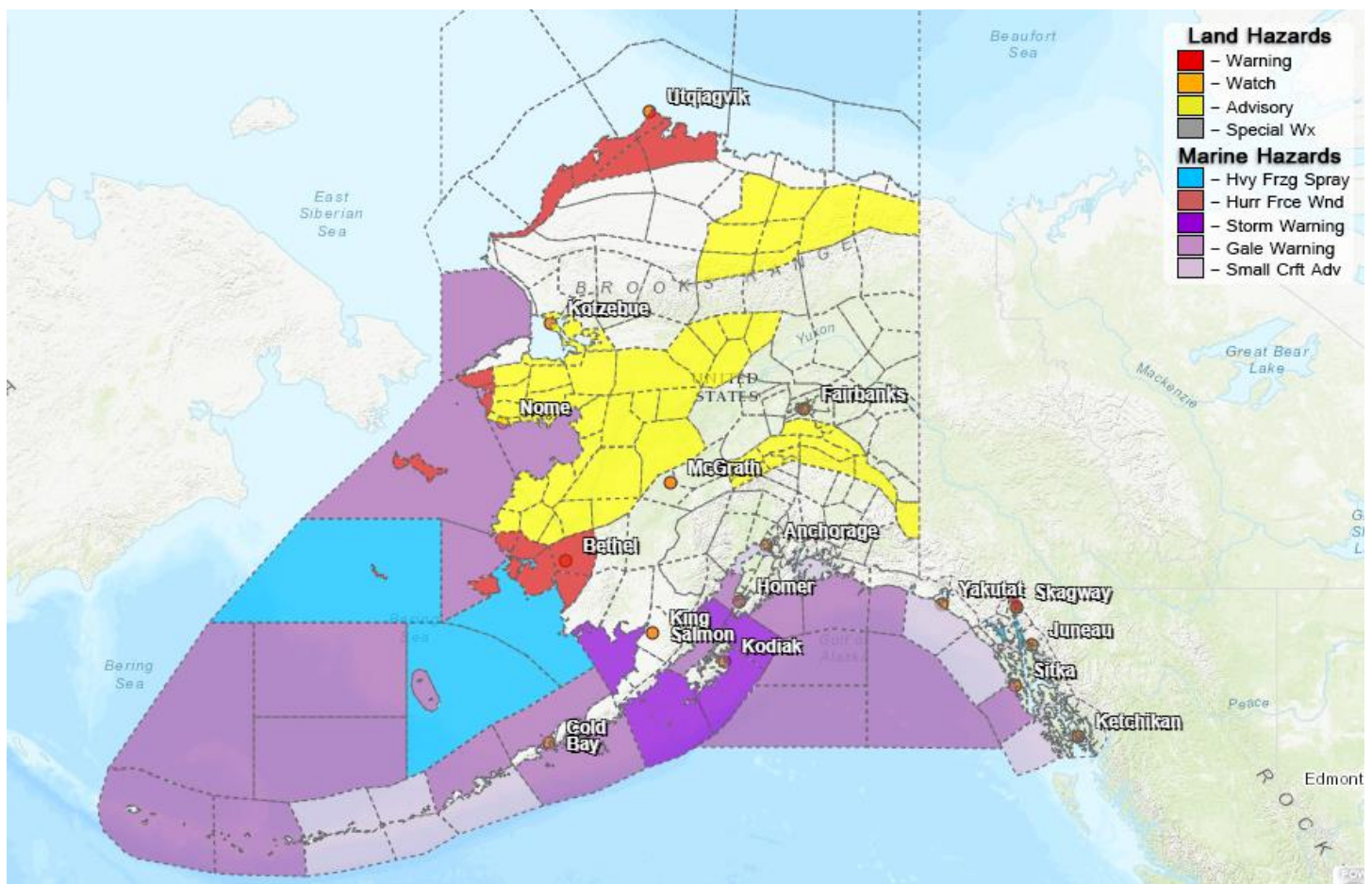

Significant Weather:



Winter Weather Advisories are in effect for the Koyukuk Valley, Northeastern Brooks Range, Eastern Norton Sound, Nulato Hills, Yukon Delta, Yukon Valley, and the Southern Seward Peninsula Coast until 6:00 A.M. tomorrow.

A Winter Storm Warning is in effect for St. Lawrence Island and the Bering Strait Coast until 6:00 A.M. tomorrow. 2 to 4 inches of snow accumulation is expected with wind chills as low as 45° below zero.

A Blizzard Warning is in effect for the Kuskokwim Delta Coast and Nunivak Island until 6:00 A.M. tomorrow. 2 to 5 inches of snow accumulation with winds gusting to 50 mph are expected in the area.

High Wind Warnings and Advisories are in effect for the Taiya Inlet and Klondike Highway, Eastern Alaska Range, Denali, Deltana, and Tanana Flats until 6:00 A.M. tomorrow.

Wind Chill Warnings and Advisories are in effect for Taiya Inlet, Baldwin Peninsula, Selawik Valley, Northern and Interior Seward Peninsula, and the Arctic Coast until 3:00 P.M. today.
