Last night at 7:15pm the Alaska Volcano Observatory (AVO) upgraded the Semisopochnoi Volcano to Warning/Red status due to an increase in ash emissions. The AVO had previously contacted nearby communities to inform them of the activity and that due to weather patterns there was no expected concerns. The AVO also contacted the SEOC Duty officer to inform them of the status change. The AVO and the SEOC will continue to monitor the situation.


