

River Watch:

The Middle Yukon River Watch Division deployed this morning to being their operations, and the deployed Upper Yukon Division will begin their demobilization process today. The SEOC continues to monitor and report on river break-up conditions and will continue active operational coordination with the National Weather Service, and local communities. In addition, the SEOC and the deployed Divisions, remain in active commination with regional tribal partners and mass care agencies including the Salvation Army and Red Cross, who are prepared to support local communities in flood response.



Significant Weather:




A Flood Watch is in effect through 4:00 P.M. today for the Yukon River near Circle
