The SEOC is deploying a Preliminary Damage Assessment team to Buckland this week. The SEOC is coordinating concurrent damage assessment activities by the DEC and voluntary agencies.

A unified command has been established at the SEOC. The SEOC continues to support statewide response to COVID-19.

# State of Alaska Department of Health and Social Services (DHSS)

The Department of Health and Social Services (DHSS) has identified the <u>dhss.alaska.gov</u> website as the target of a malware attack. The department is investigating the incident in cooperation with the appropriate authorities and is taking immediate actions to prevent further disruption and harm to its servers, systems and databases.

DHSS is operating as the Medical Branch under the State EOC/Unified Command.



## Significant Weather:




A Red Flag Warning is in effect until midnight tonight for Deltana and Tanana Flats and the Eastern Alaska Range.
