

Significant Weather:



A Special Weather Advisory is in effect through Wednesday for the Upper, Lower Kobuk and Noatak Valleys as we well as the Chukchi Sea Coast for expected heavy rainfall in the Brooks Range.

A Special Weather Statement remains in effect for the Brooks Range, and the Western Arctic Coast. Heavy rainfall is expected through Wednesday.

A Flood Watch due to increased snow melt runoff remains in effect through late Tuesday night for the Taiya Inlet, Klondike Highway, Haines Borough and the Lynn Canal.

A Special Weather Statement is in effect for the Dixon Entrance to Cape Decision, the Misty Fjords and the Southern Inner Channels for record heat expected through the middle of the week.

A Flood Advisory is in effect for the Inner Channels from Kupreanof Island to Etolin Island around the Stikine River until 2:00pm Sunday (7/4).

A Flood Warning due to increased snow melt runoff is in effect for the Juneau Borough and the Northern Admiralty Island around the Taku River until 2:00pm Sunday (7/47)
