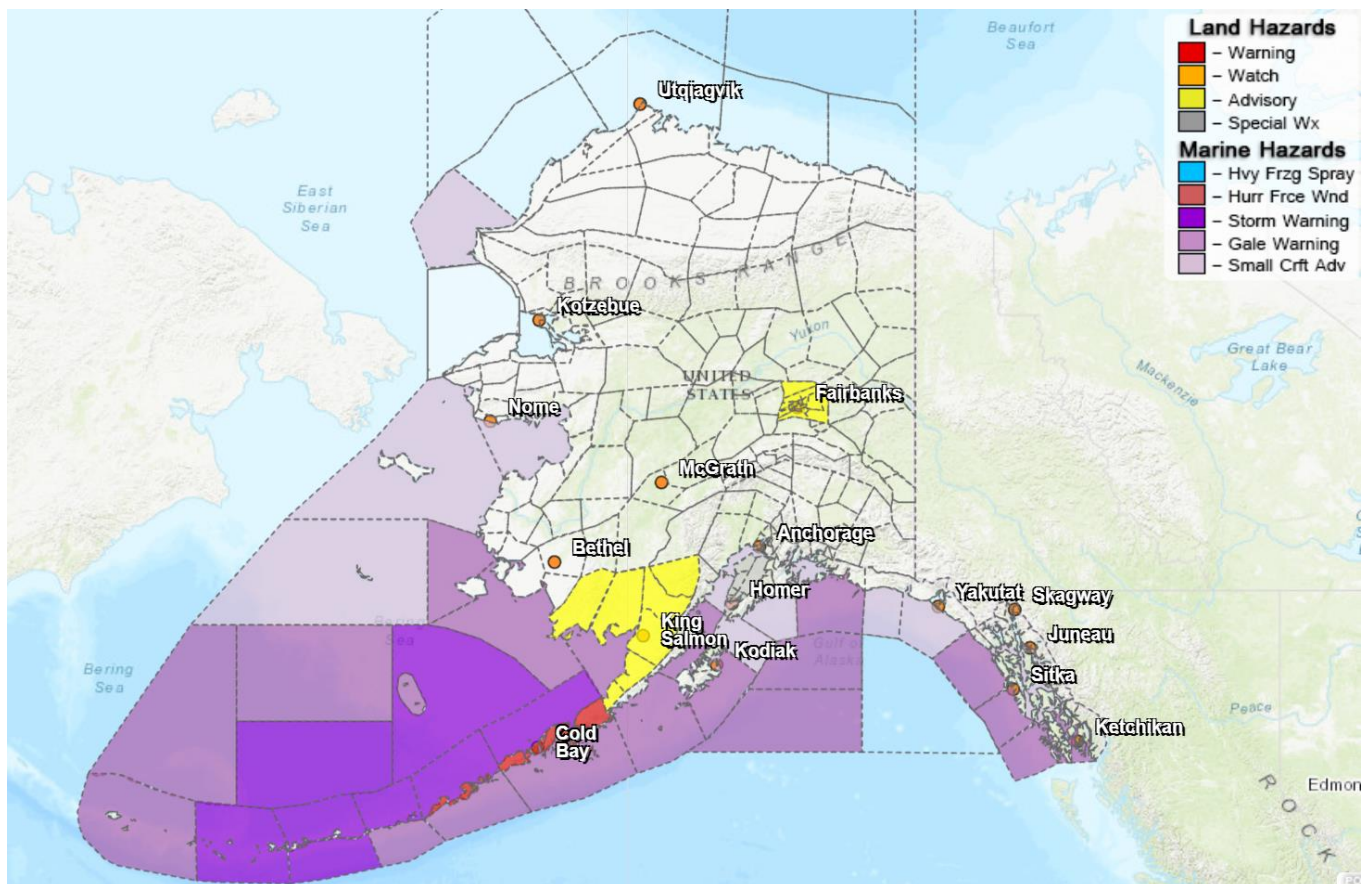

Significant Weather:



A High Wind Warning remains in effect for the Eastern Aleutians and the Alaska Peninsula until 4:00 P.M. today. 30 to 50 mph winds, with gusts to 80 mph are possible.

A Winter Weather Advisory remains in effect for the Middle Tanana Valley until 7:00 P.M. today. An additional 4 inches of snow accumulation is possible.

A Coastal Flood Advisory has been issued for the Bristol Bay coastal area from Togiak to Port Heiden from 1:00 P.M. Friday to 1:00 A.M. Saturday. Water levels 3 to 6 feet above the normal high tide line are expected in low lying areas.

A Special Weather Statement for high winds has been issued for the Pribilof Islands. 35 to 40 mph winds with gusts to 60 mph are expected between this afternoon and Friday evening.

A Special Weather Statement remains in effect for the Western Kenai Peninsula. The Skilak Glacier dammed Lake is releasing water, resulting in elevated water levels on Skilak Lake and the Kenai River. The water is expected to crest around bankfull within the next two days, and no flooding is expected.
