

## Significant Weather:



A Dense Fog Advisory is in effect for both Anchorage and Juneau until noon today.

A High Wind Warning remains in effect until noon today for Metlakatla, Ketchikan, and Prince of Wales Island, Sitka, Coffman Cove, Point Alexander, Baker, and Protection. Winds gusting to 60mph are expected.

A High Wind Warning remains in effect until 4:00 P.M. today for Unalaska and the Eastern Aleutians. Winds gusting to 90mph are expected.

A Special Weather Statement remains in effect for St. Lawrence Island. Elevated surf with water levels two feet above the normal high tide line is possible through tomorrow.
