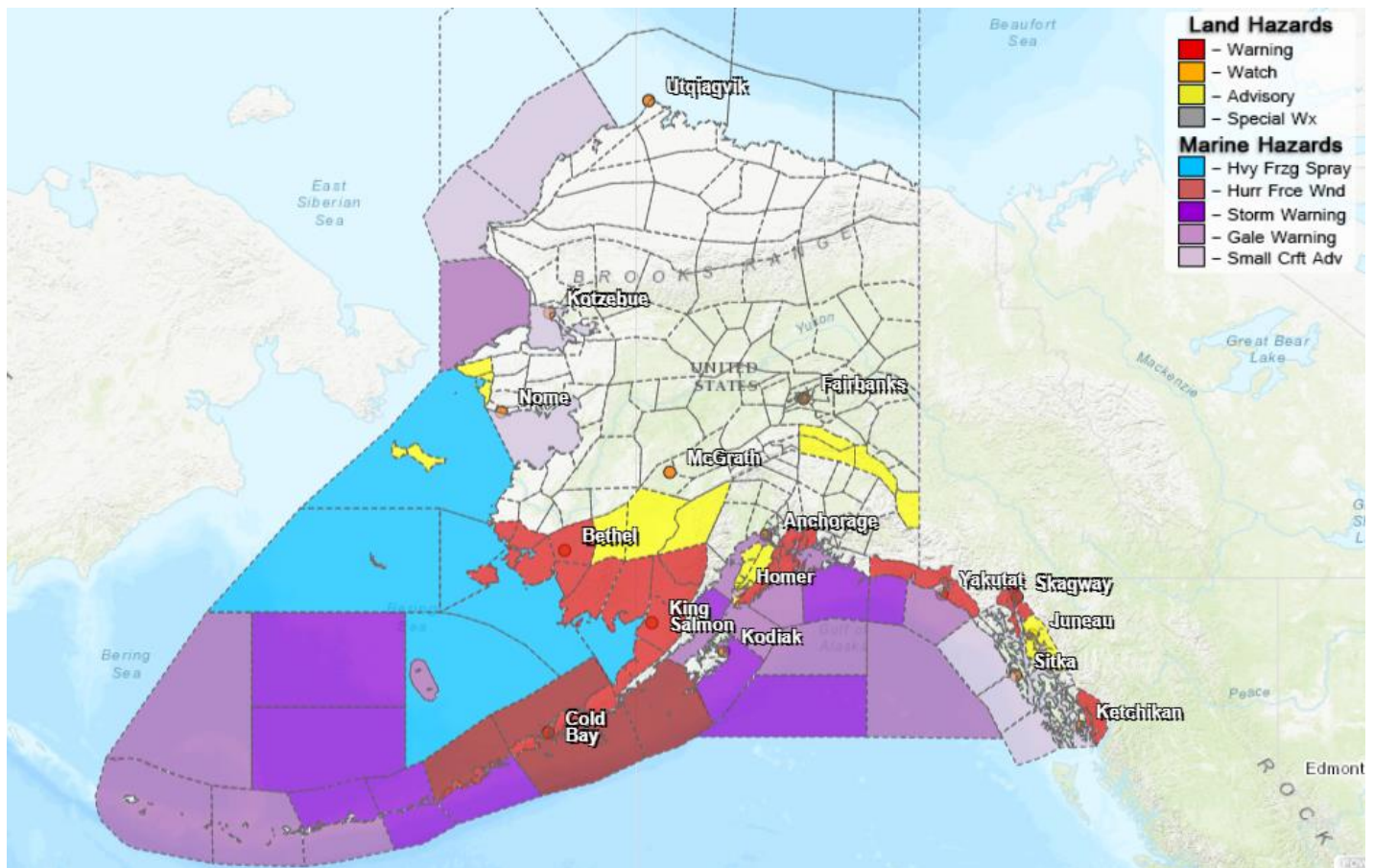

Blizzard Warnings are in effect for the following areas:

- Kuskokwim Delta region until 11am Thursday.
- A Blizzard Warning is in effect for Bristol Bay until 5pm Friday.

Coastal Flood Warnings are in effect for the following areas:

- Northern Coast of the Alaska Peninsula in low lying areas from Nelson Lagoon to the east from 9am today until 9pm this evening.
- Bristol Bay Coast in low lying areas from Naknek to the south from 12pm today until 9pm tonight.

Winter Weather Advisories remain in effect for the following areas:

- St. Lawrence Island and the Bering Strait Coast until 6am Friday.
- Eastern Alaska Range from noon today until 9pm tonight.
- Juneau and surrounding areas from 6pm Thursday until noon Friday.
- Hyder and the Misty Fjords region from 9pm this evening until 9pm Friday.
- Western Kenai Peninsula south of Clam Cultch from 9am today until noon Friday.

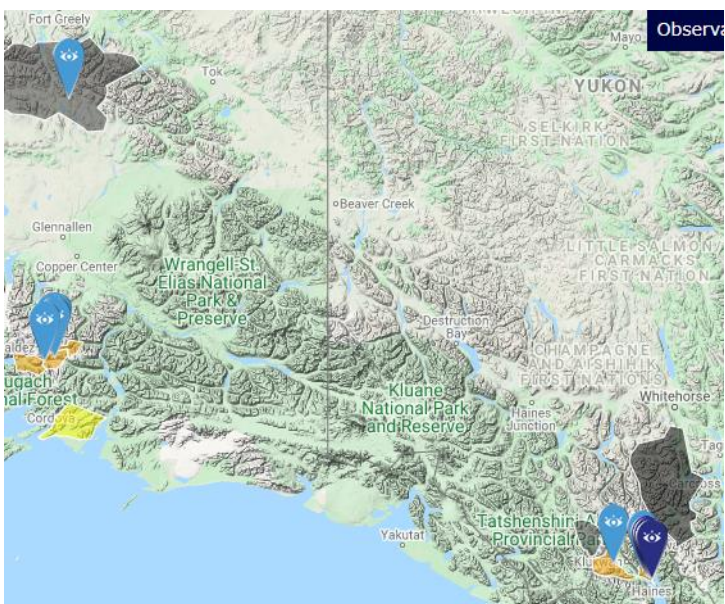
Winter Storm Warnings are in effect for the following areas:

- Northeast Gulf Coast and Yakutat from 3pm Thursday until 9am Friday.
- Skagway, Dyea, Haines, Klondike Highway, and Haines Highway from 6pm Thursday until noon Friday.
- Western Prince William Sound from 9am this morning until 6am Friday.

A High Wind Warning is in effect for the Alaska Peninsula and eastern Aleutians until 11am today. Winds of up to 90mph are possible.
