A silver alert has been issued for Stephanie Stotts. She Alaska Native, 32 years old, brown hair and brown eyes last seen wearing a blue and white rain jacket carrying a large purse. She was last seen in the area of Cushman Street and 27<sup>th</sup> Ave. Missing since 07/24/22 at 10:20AM.

**Statewide Fires**

The SEOC received a signed local disaster declaration from the Denali Borough. They are requesting state assistance for the borough and residents impacted by the Clear wildfire. The SEOC is evaluating this request.

Denali Borough downgraded all evacuation levels around the Clear Fire over the weekend. All areas are now in Ready status and all shelter locations have been closed.

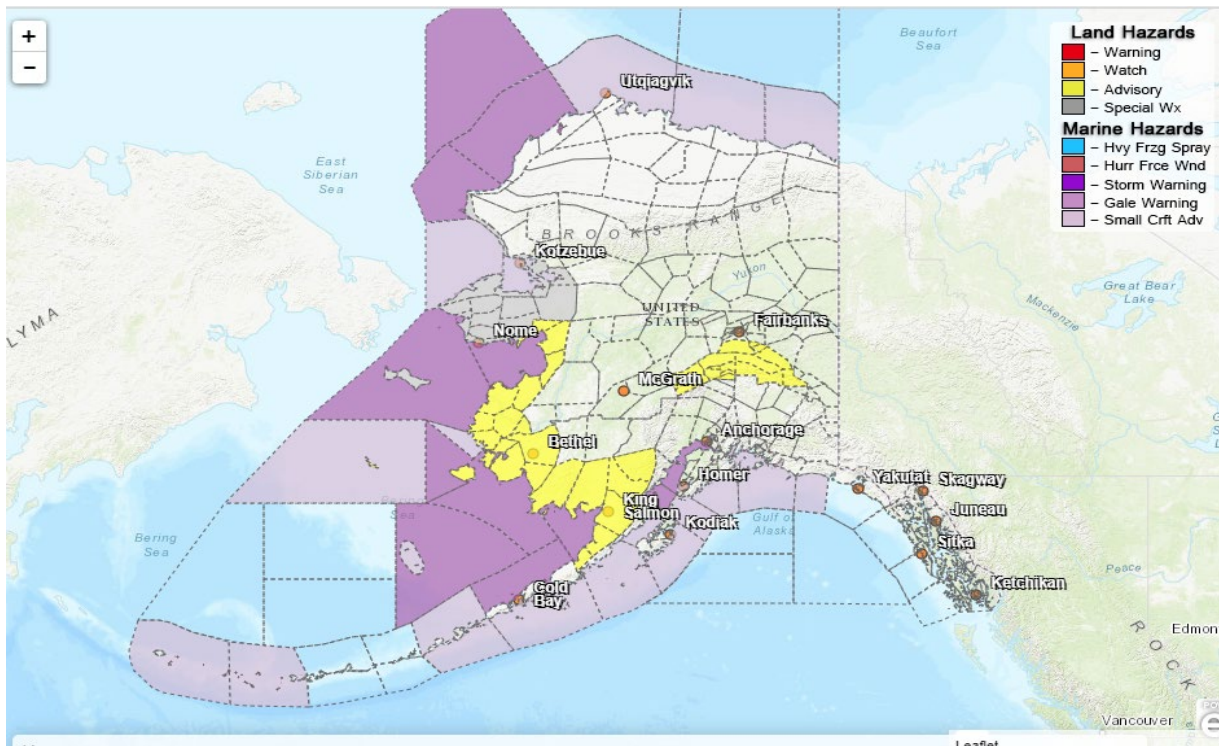
